IONA HOSTS QUINNIPIAC ON SENIOR NIGHT

The Iona College men's basketball team (11-14, 9-9 MAAC) hosts Quinnipiac (14-15, 9-10 MAAC) and the Hynes Center on Senior Night. The Gaels honor five players playing in their final home game: **Tajuan Agee, E.J. Crawford, Niksa Nikolic, Ben Perez and Mo Thiam**. With two games remaining in the regular season, the Gaels can finish anywhere between fourth and eighth in the MAAC standings prior to next week's championship.

IONA VS. QUINNIPIAC - SERIES HISTORY

- Iona and Quinnipiac square off for the 14th time in history and the in the Tim Cluess era.
- Iona leads the 9-4 following a win in this year's first meeting.
- Iona is 5-1 in New Rochelle in the six years the Bobcats have been a member of the MAAC.

SCOUTING QUINNIPIAC (14-15, 9-10 MAAC)

- Junior guard Rich Kelly leads a quartet of Bobcats with 8+ ppg with his 16.7 ppg average. He ranks No. 2 in the MAAC in scoring, No. 3 with 4.4 apg, No. 2 with 89.1 FT%, and No. 1 with 2.7 3FG/g.
- Junior forward Kevin Marfo averages 10.3 points and an NCAA-leading 13.1 rpg.
- Sophomore Tyrese Williams (9.2 ppg) and junior Jacob Rigoni (8.6) round out the teams high scorers.

LAST TIME VS. QUINNIPIAC (FEB. 7, IONA 73, QU 52)

- Iona rebounded from back-to-back 20-point losses with a resounding 73-52 road win on Feb. 7.
- **E.J. Crawford** (18p) led five Gaels in double-figures. **Isaiah Ross** had 16 points and **Tajuan Agee** posted an 11-point, 13-rebound double-double.
- Bobcat rookie Matt Balanc led with 14 points. The Gaels held the nation's top rebounder Kevin Marfo to eight boards, the only time this season he failed to reach at least 10.

LAST TIME VS. OUT (FEB. 29, NIAGARA 100, IONA 91)

- Niagara's Marcus Hammond drained a three-pointer as time expired in regulation to force overtime in the Gaels' nine-point defeat on the road.
- **Tajuan Agee** posted a career-best 28 points and **E.J. Crawford** had his first double-double of the year with 25 points and a career-best 13 boards. **Isaiah Ross** netted 16 points and five assists while **Isaiah Washington** had 10 points, and six assists in the loss.

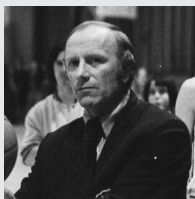

IN MEMORIAM

Gene Roberti (1930-2020)



Former Director of Athletics, baseball and men's basketball coach and Iona alumnus **Eugene Roberti '53** passed away at the age of 89 on February 8, 2020.

Roberti served as head coach of the Gaels for two seasons from

1973-75 after serving as an assistant coach to Jim McDermott and head baseball coach at Iona College. Roberti went on to coach basketball St. Francis Brooklyn and golf at NYU.

Roberti is survived by his beloved wife of 68 years, Lucy, and cherished family; children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren,

GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a **397-247 (.616)** record in regular season conference play. The Gaels' **397** wins and **.616** winning percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member. The Gaels became the first MAAC team to reach 375 wins with its win at Saint Peter's on Feb. 10, 2018, five seasons after reaching 300. Iona is currently **87** ahead of Manhattan, the No. 2 team on the list.

GAELS IN MAAC PLAY AT HOME

The Gaels finished 2018-19 with a 7-2 mark at home. Iona has won **44 of its last 60** MAAC regular season contests at the Hynes Center. Iona is **73-19 (.793)** in New Rochelle under head coach Tim Cluess. The Gaels overall record in home conference games is an outstanding **224-92 (.709)**.

AT THE HELM

- Associate head coach **Tra Arnold** - in his second year at Iona - continues to serve as acting head coach for tonight's contest as **Tim Cluess** continues to monitor a health matter.
- Before coming to Iona, Arnold spent six successful seasons head coach at Odessa College in Northwest Texas. He served three years prior as head coach at Blinn College.
- Arnold mentored more than 30 future NCAA Division I players including: LJ Figueroa (St. John's), Jermaine Haley (West Virginia), Keandre Cook (Missouri State), Josh Gray (NBA Pelicans, LSU), and Devin Davis (G-League Magic, Houston).
- Director of Operations **John Mateyko** is serving as an assistant coach of the program in Cluess' absence and the elevation of Arnold's responsibilities.

GET ME ON THE COURT AND I'M TROUBLE

- Junior **Isaiah Washington** recorded just the third triple-double in Iona men's basketball history with a 14-point, 11-assist, 10-rebound effort at Canisius Friday night.
- **Scott Machado** posted the last one on Feb. 12, 2012 at the Hynes Center with 10p, 11r and 10a.
- The first one came during the 2000 MAAC semifinal round when **Nakeia Miller** posted 14 points, 10 rebounds and 11 blocks.

BLOWOUT NOTES

- The MAAC has seen 11 of its 101 conference games played this far be decided by 20 or more points. Iona has been involved in six of them, all coming in the last 10 contests.
- It matches the most in a single-season for the Gaels following 6-0 mark in 2011-12
- Iona is 4-2 this year after its fourth straight win in those contests at Canisius Friday night.
- The six decisions is the most in the MAAC over the last five seasons ahead of Fairfield's five in 2016-17.
- The 10 in the MAAC this season stands behind 13 in both 2015-16 and 2016-17. Last year there were only three games total decided by 20 or more points.

CUPID'S ARROW

- The loss at Siena snapped a 13-game MAAC regular season and tournament winning streak on Valentines Day or later (from 3/3/18-present).
- Iona is 15-2 during the stretch.
- In 10 seasons under Tim Cluess, Iona has posted a **58-16 (.784)** record from February 14 through the completion of the MAAC Championship including 19 of the last 23 contests dating back to the 2017 tournament.

BOMBS AWAY

- For the 22nd time in school history (all in Tim Cluess-era) Iona connected on 15+ three-point field goals in a single game in its loss to Monmouth.
- With juniors **Asante Gist**, **Isaiah Ross** and **Isaiah Washington** each hitting five, it was the ninth time multiple Gaels connected on five or more.
- It was just the second time that three players hit five or more following **Schadrac Casimir** (8), **Isaiah Williams** (7) and **A.J. English** (6) vs. Delaware State on Nov. 26, 2014 in the school record effort of 24 total trifectas.
- Prior to Monmouth, the last time multiple players hit 5+ 3FG was Jan. 22, 2016 when **Deyshonee Much** and **Isaiah Williams** each hit five vs. Saint Peter's.
- In the meaningless stat department, six of the nine occasions with multiple Gaels, a player named Isaiah was involved.

MILLENNIA MEN

- Senior **E.J. Crawford** became the 14th player in Iona men's basketball history to record 1,500 career points at Rider on Jan. 10.
- He was the fourth player under Tim Cluess to reach the mark and 11th to reach 1,000 points.
- Crawford is No. 7 all-time with Arrigoni Hall of Famer Kevin Bass following a 22-point effort at Canisius. He is 39 points shy of Tariq Kirksay.
- In 10 seasons, Cluess has mentored more than 1/4 of Iona's all-time 1,000 point scorers.
- Junior Asante Gist reached 1,000 points at UConn in a college career that includes two seasons at Eastern Kentucky.

CRAWFORD NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- For the second time in his career, senior **E.J. Crawford** was picked as MAAC Player of the Week on Feb. 10. Crawford earned the honor for his performance at Quinnipiac and Fairfield.
- His first award came in the final week of the 2018-19 campaign.
- Crawford was also selected by College Sports Madness.com as its MAAC Player of the Week on both Feb. 10 and Feb. 17.

WILD STRETCH

- A five-game stretch from Jan. 31-Feb. 14 was one of the most volatile in program history as the Gaels fell to Siena and Manhattan and defeated Quinnipiac, Fairfield and the Jaspers.
- For the second time in history and first time since 1952-53 (4-1), Iona was involved in five straight 20+ point decisions.
- For the eighth time in history and first time since 1968-69, Iona won three straight games by 20 or more points.
- For the second time in history (1997-98), Iona won three straight MAAC games by 20 or more points.
- For the second time in history and first time since an eight-game stretch in 2009-10, Iona held a MAAC opponent under 60 points in three straight games.
- In the losses to Siena and Manhattan, it was just the third time in history Iona fell by 20 or more points in consecutive MAAC regular season games (1993-94, 2006-07).

KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

- No team among the 14 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona College in the last quarter century (464; Hofstra #2, 448).
- Since head coach **Tim Cluess** took the reins in 2010-11, Iona's 210 wins and .633 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 191 wins; .586 win pct.)
- Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (464), 16 more than Hofstra, 34 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.586).
- Iona's nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, two NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, **almost twice as many** Seton Hall (4 NCAA, 1 NIT) and St. John's (three NCAA, two NIT).

GIST OUT

- Following a foot injury suffered late vs. Monmouth, junior **Asante Gist** is out indefinitely.
- He will not be available for today's game.

HIGH SCORING AFFAIRS

- Iona has reached 100 points 17 times in eight-plus seasons under head coach Tim Cluess, including a single-season program record four times in 2011-12.
- Iona is **13-4** under Cluess and **53-6** all-time when scoring 100 or more.

- The Gaels scored 90 or more points 63 times in 332 (19.0%) games under Cluess and are **50-13**.
- Iona is **122-37** when reaching at least 80 points under Cluess.

WIDE MARGINS

- The Gaels are **117-40** in games decided by 10 or more points since head coach **Tim Cluess** took the reins in 2010-11.
- After winning 81 of the first 99 double-digit decisions in his first six seasons (81-18, .818), Iona is 36-21 (.632) since 2016-17.
- During the MAAC regular season, the program is **76-10 (.883)** in MAAC regular season games decided by 10 or more points under Cluess.
- In 14 seasons as an NCAA head coach, Cluess has lost just 16 games by 15 or more points.
- Iona's 126-76 win over Delaware State was the second 50+ point victory in program history and first since the 1967-68 (46 years) campaign.
- In his 13 seasons as an NCAA coach, Cluess has mentored his team to a **177-42** mark in 10+ point contests.

20/20 VISION

- Iona's 20+ win season streak snapped at nine following the 2018-19 campaign.
- Iona recorded its ninth straight and 22nd all-time 20+ win seasons in the 76-year history of the program in 2017-18.
- It set a program record for consecutive 20+ win seasons, surpassing the previous high of four straight from 1981-85.

• Tim Cluess is the only (of 12 all-time) head coach in program history to earn 20 wins in each of his first eight seasons in New Rochelle. He is also the Iona coach to boast more than four 20+ win seasons as the leader of the Maroon & Gold (Pat Kennedy, 4).

NINE STRAIGHT 20-WIN SEASONS

- The Gaels had an unprecedented run of 20-win seasons in MAAC history. The nine-year stretch more than doubled the previous MAAC mark of four set by the Maroon & Gold from 1981-85 and matched by La Salle (1986-90) and Siena (2006-10).
- In MAAC history, consecutive 20+ win streaks have happened only 17 times.
- Iona has recorded 19 of its 22 20+ win seasons as a member of the MAAC, the most of any league member. Siena has posted 12, Manhattan nine and Saint Peter's eight.

LET IT RAIN

- Since 2000-01, Iona has produced 149 games with 10 or more three-point field goals. Five came in the seven seasons under head coach **Jeff Ruland** and seven came with **Kevin Willard** at the helm (three years).
- Under **Tim Cluess**, Iona has posted 138 games (22 in 2013-14, 18 in 2014-15, 15 in 2015-16, 20 in 2016-17, 14 in 2017-18 & 2018-19) with double-digit trifectas.
- The Gaels shattered a school record with 24 3FG on Nov. 26 vs. Delaware State, beating the previous mark of 18, reached twice (at Albany, Nov. 23, 2010; vs. Liberty, Dec. 18, 2012).
- The Maroon & Gold set its No. 2 total of 20 3FG made in an 82-68 win at Holy Cross on Dec. 19, 2017. The first 10 field goals made in the contest were from distance as the team set a first half program record with 12 in the win.
- Iona's top 31 three-point field goal efforts have come with Cluess as head coach.
- Against Liberty, Iona's 41 three-point attempts set a

- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their **1,063** games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

CLUESS RANKS SECOND ALL-TIME IN WINS

- Head coach **Tim Cluess** became No. 2 on Iona's all-time coaching wins list at the end of the 2015-16 campaign, surpassing Goal Club Hall of Famer **Jeff Ruland's** mark of 139 over nine seasons.

- Cluess has led Iona to **133 MAAC regular season wins** through nine-plus seasons, **the second most in conference history** behind former Niagara skipper Joe Mihalich (166 in 15 seasons).

- Iona men's basketball has recorded 10 straight seasons with at least 10+ MAAC regular season wins, extending the league's longest streak.

- The program set the record in 2017-18, surpassing the eight in a row recorded by the Gaels from 1995-03 and Niagara from 1997-05.

- Overall, Iona has 22 10+ win seasons in 38 years in the MAAC followed by Siena (17), Rider/Niagara (14) and Manhattan/Saint Peter's/Fairfield (13).

CURSE REVERSED

- The No. 1 seed won the MAAC tournament championship for the first time in nine seasons in 2019. Siena, Times Union Center, 2010).

- The MAAC's top seed won a championship that was not on its home floor for the first time in 14 years (Niagara, 2005).

- It is Iona's fourth MAAC regular season championship and No. 1 seed in nine seasons under head coach Tim Cluess. The Gaels were upset in the semifinal round in 2012 but earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament. Iona fell to Manhattan in back-to-back seasons as the No. 1 seed in the MAAC championship game in 2014 and 2015.

- Iona head coach Tim Cluess became the third head coach in MAAC history to record 100 regular season wins.

- Cluess is joined by Joe Mihalich (Niagara) and Jimmy Patsos (Loyola/Siena) and newly inducted the century club member John Dunne (Saint Peter's/Marist) as MAAC coaches with 100+ wins.

- Cluess was also the fastest of the trio to reach the mark (131 games) with Mihalich becoming the first in 159 games and Patsos the second in 188 games.

RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

Iona honored the legacy of **Richie Guerin '54** by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.

Guerin is an Iona College Goal Club (1983), Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.

He rewrote the basketball record books at Iona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.

A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.

Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.

In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

GAEL GREATS

In addition to Naismith Hall of Famer **Richie Guerin '54**, here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:

Jim Valvano - legendary head coach at Iona from 1975-80 who "Dared To Dream" to win a national championship with the Gaels and finally did in 1983, albeit with North Carolina State. Succumbed to cancer in 1993 eight weeks after

an impassioned speech at the ESPY Awards that year which in which he announced creation of The V Foundation for Cancer Research and its motto, "Don't Give Up... Don't Ever Give Up."

Jeff Ruland '91 - All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.

Pat Kennedy - head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle. He was most recently head coach at Div. II Pace University in Pleasantville, NY, located 19 miles North of Iona.

Warren Isaac '65 - Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.

Tim Welsh - head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.

Kevin Willard - Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big East's Seton Hall. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.

Steve Burt '84 & Steve Burt '06 - All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burt, the father, had a four-season NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.

Sean Green '91 - Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.

Scott Machado '12 - The last Gael to appear in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. Played the majority 2018-19 season in the NBA G-League for the South Bay Lakers and played four games with the Los Angeles Lakers. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in Australia.

Bob Santini '53 - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

NOTABLE ALUMNI (ATHLETICS/POP CULTURE)

Brendan Malone '62 - longtime NBA assistant coach, last with the Detroit Pistons from 2014-16.

Don McLean - Singer-songwriter noted most famous for his 1971 single "American Pie".

Dennis Leonard - Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer and 12-year MLB veteran who won 20 games on three occasions from 1977-80. He was inducted in May 2015 into the New York Baseball Hall of Fame.

Kyle Flood '93 - Former head football coach at Rutgers, current OL coach at Alabama.

Maggie Timoney '89 - The Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer recently became the first female CEO of Heineken USA.

Jason Motte - Major League Baseball relief pitcher recorded the final out of the 2011 World Series with the world champion St. Louis Cardinals. Has also appeared in Major League games with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies and Atlanta Braves.

Leonard Korir '12 - a two time NCAA track and field champion while at Iona, Korir represented Team USA in the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in the 10,000-meter event. He is currently ranked as the top American marathon runner on WorldAthletics.org.

Amanda Saccomanno '13 - World Wrestling Entertainment's (WWE) *Mandy Rose*, competes on the SmackDown brand.

Ignacio Maganto - was selected by the LA Galaxy with the 21st pick in the first round of the 2015 MLS SuperDraft, the first Major League Soccer draft pick in Iona history. Maganto scored his first MLS goal with the Galaxy in the spring of 2015.

Mariano Rivera III '15 - Earned his degree in May 2015 and was selected in the fourth round by the Washington Nationals.

Here is the weekly review of the top performing Gaels alumni, who are currently playing pro basketball.

- Steve Burtt** (6'3"-G-84, graduated '06, plays pro in Argentina) led Gimnasia to a victory over the league outsider Libertad Sunchales (5-18) 99-80 in the Argentinian La Liga on Sunday night. He was MVP of the game. Burtt scored 25 points in 21 minutes. Gimnasia y Esgrima Comodoro Rivadavia (7-13) is placed 16th in the La Liga. It was his team's fourth consecutive victory in a row. Burtt has relatively good stats this season 11.3ppg and 1.2rpg. He is a naturalized Ukrainian.
- Sean Armand** (6'5"-SG-91, graduated '14, plays in France) was the main contributor in a ES Chalons-Sur-Saone's surprising victory against the third-ranked ASVEL Lyon-Villeurbanne Basket (19-4) 99-96 in the French Jeep ELITE ProA in Tuesday night's game. He was MVP of the game. Armand scored 23 points (went 7 for 7 at the free throw line). ES Chalons-Sur-Saone (9-14) is placed 12th in the Jeep ELITE ProA. It was his team's third consecutive victory in a row. Armand has individually a very good year with high stats. He averages 19.2ppg, 2.0rpg and 2.8apg in five games he played so far.
- Scott Machado** (6'1"-G-90, graduated '12, currently in Australia), who plays in the Australian NBL could not help Cairns Taipans (16-12) in their game last Thursday. Despite his good performance Cairns Taipans were badly defeated 99-83 on the road by the lower-ranked United (#5). Machado recorded 10 points, 6 rebounds and 9 assists in 33 minutes. - Taylor Bessick** (6'9"-F/C-92, graduated '17, currently in Georgia) was the major contributor in Tskhum-Abkhazeti's victory against the fifth-ranked Olimpi 63-62 in a derby game in the Georgian Superleague last Friday. He scored 12 points and blocked 2 shots. This year Bessick averages 10.0ppg, 1.5rpg and 1.5bpg in two games.
- Isaiah Williams** (6'7"-G/F-92, graduated '16, plays pro in Switzerland) managed to help Union Neuchatel Basket to win against the sixth-ranked Boncourt 78-76 in the Swiss SBL on Saturday night. Williams recorded only 2 points in 6 minutes on the court. This season Williams averages 7.9ppg, 5.1rpg and 2.7apg.
- Bryan Matthew** (6'5"-F-76, graduated '97, plays in Antigua) contributed to an easy victory against one of league's weakest teams HS Outlaws crushing them 94-56 in the Antiguan ABBA in Thursday night's game. Matthew had a double-double by scoring 13 points and making 10 passes. He also added 9 rebounds and 3 steals. Matthew has very impressive stats this year 20.0ppg, 8.0rpg, 3.5apg and 1.8spg in four games.
- Vangelis Bebis** (6'6"-G/F-95, graduated '15, currently in Germany) couldn't help Koblenz in their game against HAKRO Merlins Crailsheim 2nd team in the German Regionalliga (fourth division). He scored 5 points and added 5 passes in 28 minutes. His team was defeated 84-77. This season Bebis averages 9.2ppg, 4.2rpg, 5.8apg and 2.0spg.
- TK Edogi** (6'8"-F-94, graduated '18, plays pro in Israel) couldn't help H.Ramat Gan in their game against Bnei Hasharon in the Israeli National League (second division). He recorded 5 points and grabbed 5 rebounds. His team was crushed by 30 points 96-66. Edogi has very impressive stats this year 15.5ppg, 11.0rpg, 1.2apg and 1.8bpg in 19 games. He is a naturalized Nigerian.

- Tim Cluess was named 12th head coach of the Iona College men's basketball program on April 8, 2010 and is in his 10th season with the Gaels.
- Came to New Rochelle with an impressive 20-year coaching resume after spending four seasons as head coach at LIU Post in Brookville, NY.
- One thing can be said, he is a winner. After spending 14 years as head coach at St. Mary's High School in Manhasset, NY, he spent the five years prior to arriving at Iona in the college ranks at Suffolk Community College and LIU Post.
- He amassed a 120-33 record and had unprecedented success at both schools.
- When combining his high school record, Cluess has won nearly 75 percent of his games coached.
- Led the Gaels to 20+ wins in each of his first eight seasons in New Rochelle, the only coach in school history to accomplish the feat. The Gaels won 25 games in three of them.
- Iona appeared in its ninth straight postseason tournament in 2019 including a CIT championship game appearance in 2011, the NCAA First Four in 2012 with the MAAC's second ever at-large bid, the 2013 NCAA tournament and the 2014 and 2015 NIT before returning to the 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 NCAA Tournaments.
- The Gaels were crowned MAAC Tournament Champions in 2013, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 and MAAC Regular Season Champions in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2019. The Cluess-led program set a school record with 17 conference wins in 2013-14 and 2014-15.
- Cluess was named MAAC Coach of the Year following the 2013-14 and 2018-19 campaigns.
- Under Cluess, Iona has consistently been among the top scoring teams in the nation. The Gaels finished 13th in 2010-11, first in both 2011-12 and 2012-13, fourth in 2013-14, fifth in 2014-15 and 27th in 2015-16 and Top 50 in 2016-17 and 2017-18.
- In each of his eight seasons at Iona, the team's scoring averages rank in the Top 12 in school history including a school record 83.6 points per game during the 2013-14 season.

- In addition to being the 2011-12 and 2012-13 NCAA scoring champions, the Gaels were NCAA statistical champs in total three-point field goals made in 2014-15 (344), three-point field goals per game (10.2/g) in 2013-14 and assists per game (19.3/g) in 2011-12.
- Other Top 10 NCAA statistical marks include fourth in assists in 2010-11 (17.4/g), second in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.54:1) and third in field goal percentage (50.8%) in 2011-12, second in free throw percentage (78.1%) in 2012-13 and

third in assists (17.5/g), fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.65:1) in 2013-14 and fourth in scoring (79.5/g), fifth in 3FG per game (9.8/g) and seventh in assists (16.4/g) in 2014-15.

- Cluess has mentored three MAAC Players of the Year and two Haggerty Award Winners. **Scott Machado** (2012), **Lamont Jones** (2013) and **David Laury** (2015) earned the MAAC's top honor while Machado and Jones also were the fifth and sixth players in Iona basketball history to earned the New York Metropolitan Area's Player of the Year honor.
- Iona has seen 12 different student-athletes earn 21 All-MAAC honors including 13 on the first team. Jones (2013), Machado (2011, 2012), Laury (2015), **Mike Glover** (2011, 2012), **Sean Armand** (2014), **A.J. English** (2014, 2015, 2016), **Jordan Washington** (2017), **E.J. - **Scott Machado**, who was also coached by Cluess during his freshman season at St. Mary's High School, appeared in six regular season games in the

NBA with the Houston Rockets and five postseason games with the Golden State Warriors in 2012-13.

- Machado is one of several Iona Gaels to have played for Cluess to continue their playing careers in the professional ranks including: **Sean Armand**, **Vangelis Bebis**, **Taylor Bessick**, **Tre Bowman**, **Sam Cassell Jr.**, **Randy Dezouvre**, **TK Edogi**, **A.J. English**, **Mike Glover**, **Jayon James**, **Ra'Shad James**, **Lamont Jones**, **David Laury**, **Zach Lewis**, **Deyshonee Much**, **Ibn Muhammad**, **Chris Pelcher**, **Taaj Ridley**, **Alejo Rodriguez**, **Aaron Rountree**, **Jon Severe**, **Jan Svandrik**, **Jordan Washington**, and **Isaiah Williams**.

• Prior to Iona, Cluess' LIU Post Pioneers earned a 23-6 overall record in his last season, earning victories in 19 of their last 21 contests. The squad earned its fourth straight berth in the East Coast Conference championship game. Cluess was named the ECC Co-Coach of the Year for the third straight time.

• In 2008-09, LIU Post had its finest season in history, setting a school record with 30 victories. Standing among the top 10 teams in the nation from January through March in 2009, the Pioneers were ranked as high as No. 2 that year.

• The squad posted an undefeated regular season, winning all 24 games for the first time in school history. LIU Post won its second straight ECC regular season and tournament championship titles and defeated Bentley in overtime in front of thousands on their home court to win the NCAA East Region Championship title and advance to the Elite Eight Tournament in Springfield, Mass.

• For his outstanding efforts, Cluess was named the Basketball Times Division II Co-Coach of the Year as well as Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year for the second straight season.

• The 2007-08 season saw Cluess' squad post a 26-5 overall record, including an 18-2 clip in the conference. LIU Post claimed its first regular season and conference titles since the 2003-04 season with a 60-57 win to advance to the NCAA Northeast Regional at Bentley College. He was voted the ECC Coach of the Year by his peers, and was named the MWBA Division II Coach of the Year.

• In 2006-07, his first year at the helm, Cluess guided the Pioneers to a 19-11 record and an appearance in the ECC Championship game.

He improved the team's win total by six from the season before he took over the program.

• Cluess was named the eighth head men's basketball coach in the 50-year history of the Pioneers' program in April of 2006, after spending the 2005-06 campaign as the head men's basketball coach at Suffolk Community College in Brentwood, NY. He led a team of eight players to a 22-10 record overall, as well as a Region XV championship and a fourth-place finish in the NJCAA Division III Tournament. The trip to the national tournament was the first in the Longhorns' history, and Cluess was tabbed the District 5 Coach of the Year.

• Prior to his ascent to the college ranks, Cluess was a standout head coach at St. Mary's High School in Manhasset, NY from 1991-05, where the Gaels went a remarkable 264-78 (.772) during his tenure.

• St. Mary's won a record eight consecutive Nassau-Suffolk CHSAA league championships from 1997-98 to 2004-05. In that final season with Cluess as their mentor, the Gaels went 25-1 and finished the season ranked in the Top 20 nationally after holding the No. 1 ranking for eight weeks of the campaign.

• Cluess helped develop more than 50 players who moved on to the collegiate and professional ranks at St. Mary's including former North Carolina standout and current San Antonio Spur Danny Green.

• He won four state titles and two Federation championships at the Manhasset school. Cluess was a seven-time coach of the year in the high school ranks and earned tournament wins in national tournaments such as the Beach Ball Classic and the Las Vegas Prep Classic.

• Cluess played professional basketball in Europe and Australia after a collegiate career at both St. John's and Hofstra.

• He attended St. John's from 1978-81, before completing his coursework at Hofstra from 1982-83.

• Cluess holds a bachelor's degree in Accounting from Hofstra and currently resides in Floral Park, N.Y. with his wife, Karen, and their two children - Kevin and T.J.
