The Iona College men's basketball team (18-3, 10-0 MAAC) begins its longest road trip of the season and a pivotal part of its schedule at Canisius (7-15, 3-8 MAAC). The Gaels look to remain unbeaten in MAAC play when it begins its annual Western NY swing at the Koessler Center on ESPN3.

IONA VS. CANISIUS - SERIES HISTORY

- The Gaels and Griffis meet for the 79th time in history with Iona holding a 45-33 advantage.
- Iona has won five straight and 12 of the last 16 meetings.
- The Maroon & Gold has struggled in Buffalo, posting just a 14-22 mark on Canisius' home floor.
- The Griffis are the lone team on Iona's schedule this year to have a better than .500 record all-time vs. Rick Pitino. Its two wins coming while Coach Pitino was head coach at Boston University in 1982 and 1983, and its defeat came vs. Kentucky in 1997.

SCOUTING CANISIUS (7-15, 3-8 MAAC)

- Canisius has dropped three straight on the road.
- The Griffis are 7-3 at home and winless away from Buffalo.
- Four players average 9+ points led by Armon Harried's 12.0 ppg. Harried is No. 2 with 27 3FG and tied for first with 11 blocks.
- Malek Green averages 10.4 ppg and is also No. 2 with 4.7 rpg.
- Jordan Henderson has posted 10.2 ppg with a team-best 39 3FG and 11 blocks.
- Ahmadou Fofana averages 9.2 ppg and team-high 3.3 apg.
- The Griffis were selected to finish 11th in the MAAC this season.

GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a 413-252 (.621) record in regular season play.
- The Gaels' 413 wins and .621 win percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member.
- The Gaels became the first team to reach 400 wins with its win at Rider on Dec. 19, 2020.
- Iona is currently 89 wins ahead of Siena, the No. 2 team on the list.

GAELS IN MAAC PLAY AWAY FROM HOME

The Gaels improved to 15 games over .500 in MAAC road contests all-time following its win at Quinnipiac on Jan. 23. The program record for regular season MAAC road wins is eight (2005-06, 2013-14, 2015-16). Iona holds a 171-156 (.523) in its 41st season in the MAAC.

RECEIVING VOTES

• For the second straight week and third of the season, Iona has received votes in the Associated Press Top 25 poll.

• The Gaels earned six votes in this week's poll, believed to be the most in the last quarter-century.

• Three voters placed the Maroon & Gold on their ballot: Andrew Kahn from Ann Arbor News/MLive in Michigan, David Cloninger from The State in Columbia, SC and Mia O'Brien from First Coast News in Jacksonville, FL.

• Iona earned a vote from Ethan Joyce of the Winston-Salem Journal earlier this season following its win over Alabama.

• Iona previously received votes in the preseason poll in 2015-16 (six years ago), four straight weeks in January and February of 2012, six straight polls in December 2005 and January 2006 and during a 15-game winning streak from Dec. 1997 - Feb. 1998.

• The last MAAC team to receive votes on the AP Top 25 poll was Monmouth on Feb. 27, 2017 with 3 votes in the Week 17 poll.

• The last time Iona was ranked in the AP Top 25 poll was on Mar. 4, 1980.

HOT MAAC START

• The Gaels are 10-0 in MAAC play for the first time in its 41 seasons in the league.

• Iona won its first six games in 1995-96 and 2015-16.

• The Maroon & Gold are the sixth team to begin the MAAC regular season with at least 10 wins and first since Siena in 2009-10. The Saints won their first 14 games in route to a 17-1 regular season finish.

TURNING POINT

• Since falling to Quinnipiac in Hamden last season, the Gaels have posted a **24-4** record including **16** straight against MAAC opponents.

• Iona's losses have been to two Top 10 teams in Alabama in the NCAA Tournament and Kansas and two teams poised to contend for their league titles this season in Belmont and St. Louis.

• Iona's 12 straight regular season MAAC wins is a school record, breaking the previous mark of 11 earned in 1997-98, 2013-14 and 2014-15.

• The Gaels 16 straight wins including postseason play is also a school record.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

• **Iona has erased a nine-point or more deficit in five of its victories this season following its performance at Fairfield.**

• The Gaels trailed by 11 points with 7:28 remaining in Bridgeport, outscoring the Stags 21-6 before the final buzzer.

• Against Marist at home, the Maroon & Gold used an 11-2 run late to pull out a victory and trailed by nine points with 6:38 to play.

• In the Gaels win over Delaware, Iona trailed by 11 early in the first half.

• At Marist, the Gaels trailed by seven points with 2:29 left to play before ripping of 14 straight points in the seven-point victory.

• Iona overcame its largest deficit of the season vs. Liberty, erasing a 16-point first half deficit.

• It is the largest deficit overcome in a win since the season opener vs. Albany in 2018 (15 points).

• **Iona has trailed or been tied at the half in nine of its 18 wins this season.**

WEEKLY HONORS

• Graduate **Elijah Joiner**, sophomore **Nelly Junior Joseph** and freshman **Walter Clayton Jr.** have taken home MAAC Weekly honors this season.

• Joiner earned the nod on Monday (Jan. 24) for his performance in the Gaels road wins at Monmouth and Quinnipiac.

• Jr. Joseph earned a Player of the Week award for his performance at the 2021 ESPN Events Invitational and Clayton posted back-to-back Rookie of the Week accolades on Dec. 27 and Jan. 3.

• Last season, Jr. Joseph was Rookie of the Week four times and **Isaiah Ross** was a 3x MAAC Player of the Week honoree in head coach **Rick Pitino's** first year in New Rochelle.

MID MAJOR POLLING

• Iona has been a consensus top 10 mid-major program based on available polls from various constituents.

• Iona jumped to No. 2 on the CollegeInsider.com Men's Mid-Major Top 25 in the Week 10 poll following two more MAAC wins last week. It is the highest the Gaels have ever been ranked in the poll. The program sits behind unanimous No. 1 Gonzaga, who is eligible for the poll by virtue of its affiliation with the West Coast Conference.

• Field of 68 Media Network places Iona at No. 4, its highest ranking of the season and Mid-Major Madness place Iona as No. 6.

• Several of Iona's opponents from the 2021-22 season can be found on the polls as well, including: Belmont, Hofstra, Liberty and Monmouth.

• All polls can be found on page 7.

ROTHSTEIN 45

• CBS Sports Jon Rothstein ranks his Top 45 programs in NCAA Division I weekly, a list that has contained the Gaels since its win over Alabama in November.

• This week's ranking puts Iona at No. 38 with only a quartet of Big East schools ahead of it among teams from the Northeast region (Villanova [14], Providence [16], UConn [17], Seton Hall [37]).

MAKE 'EM COUNT

- The Gaels rank **No. 1 in free throw attempts per game and rank No. 4 in makes** through Thursday.
- Iona's (24.3 FTA/g) is ahead of Long Beach State's 23.6 per contest.
- Seton Hall (17.2 FTM/g), Manhattan (16.94) and Arkansas (16.91) average more makes per game than Iona's 16.90.
- Sophomore **Nelly Junior Joseph** is 35th in individual free throws attempted with 119.

BLOCK PARTY

- Iona ranks **No. 5 in the NCAA in blocks per game, rejecting 6.2 per contest through 21 games.**
- Auburn is the nation's leader at 8.1 per game.
- Among mid-majors, the Gaels rank second, behind Rhode Island.
- **Nelly Junior Joseph** is the team's leader with 1.8 blocks per game. **Berrick JeanLouis** (1.1) also averages a block or more per game.
- Iona's block total of 131 is also No. 3 in the NCAA.

NELLY NELLY

- Junior **Nelly Junior Joseph** has recorded a even double-doubles, No. 2 in the MAAC
- He had three straight vs. Rider, Yale and Delaware and went back-to-back vs. Alabama and Belmont and **ranked 32nd** in the NCAA with his seven on the season.
- The NCAA leaders are Utah Valley's Fardaws Aimaq and UNC's Armando Bacot with 17.

WIN PERCENTAGE

- With 18 wins in 21 tries, Iona's .857 win percentage is tied for 11th best in the NCAA.
- Only seven teams in the NCAA have more wins than the Gaels after Wednesday's games: Auburn (21), South Dakota State (20), Murray State (20), Purdue (19), Baylor (19) and Providence (19).
- Iona's 18 wins are tied with eight other teams.

OTHER NOTABLE NATIONAL STATS

- Sophomore **Nelly Junior Joseph** ranks No. 9 nationally in offensive rebounds per game (3.62).
- Graduate **Dylan van Eyck** leads the MAAC and is 84th nationally with a 2.12 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- **Among forwards, van Eyck is No. 3 nationally. He and Liberty's Kyle Rode are the only forwards to lead their conferences in the statistic.**

ABOUT THAT SCHEDULE

- **Among Iona's 11 non-conference opponents were eight teams that are picked to win, as runner-up or third in its conference.** Belmont (OVC), Delaware (CAA), Kansas (Big 12), Liberty (ASun), and Yale (Ivy) were picked first, Harvard (Ivy) and No. 10 Alabama (SEC) were picked second and Saint Louis (A10) third in its league's preseason polls.
- Iona's three other opponents include: 2021 NCAA participant App State; 2020 NCAA qualifier Hofstra; and North Alabama, who reached the ASun tournament championship game in March.
- **In a rare feat for a mid-major program, Iona's only true non-conference road game on the**

schedule happened in an on-the-fly scheduling adjustment to face Saint Louis in early January. The Gaels' other 10 included three home games and seven neutral site games.

KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

- No team among the 14 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona College in the 27 seasons (495; Hofstra #2, 477).
- Over the last decade-plus, Iona's 241 wins and .643 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 218 wins; .581 win pct.)
- Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (495), 18 more than Hofstra, 38 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.592).
- Iona's 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA, two NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, **twice as many** Seton Hall (4 NCAA, 1 NIT) and St. John's (three NCAA, two NIT).

2022 INCOMING CLASS

- Head coach **Rick Pitino** announced the signing of two players for next season.
- **Sadiku Ayo** is a 6-6 wing and native of Ghana in West Africa. He currently attends Our Saviour Lutheran School in the Bronx and plays AAU ball for the NY Lightning.
- Ayo is a versatile, two-way wing, who thrives at both ends of the floor. He has been hailed as a strong, mature performer with great leadership ability. On the offensive end, he has been equally successful driving to the rim or shooting from distance. Defensively he is capable of defending all 5 positions on the floor.
- **Keither Florence** is a 6-6.5 forward from Wichita, Kansas and is spending his postgrad season at Pro Holmes Sports Academy in Tampa, FL.
- Florence is also a two-way performer with good length and athleticism along with a high motor. He has shown consistency in his mid- and outside range while also being proficient in the post with a knack for rebounding. As a senior in 2020-21, Florence spent time at Colorado Prep in Colorado Springs and as a junior in 2019-20, he attended Campus High School in Wichita
- Iona currently has four graduate students who will exhaust eligibility following this season.

• It is the first-ever win for a MAAC team against a team in the AP Top 10 (1-119).

THE MOST MAGICAL PLACE ON EARTH

• The Field House at ESPN's Wide World of Sports was Iona's home for five straight contests as the Gaels competed in events in back-to-back weeks at the facility located in Walt Disney World.

• Two weeks ago, the Gaels took on Liberty and North Alabama in the MAAC/ASun Challenge.

• Iona celebrated Thanksgiving at the ESPN Events Invitational with an opening match against AP No. 10 Alabama, a second round matchup with Belmont and the event finale vs. AP No. 4 Kansas.

A QUICK 10 GAMES

• December 3 is the earliest Iona has 10 games in hand in the history of the program, by eight days.

• Previously, December 11, in 2011-12, was the earliest the Gaels played their 10th contest.

• Due to COVID-19 issues last season, Game #10 for Iona last season came on February 13.

6-0 START

• Iona won its first six contests of the season for the first time since 2005-06, when the program started 7-0.

• The Gaels started 6-0 for the sixth time in the 77-year history of the program, and just the third time in the last 40 seasons.

• Iona's best all-time starts were 10-0 in 1949-50, 7-0 in 1984-85 and 2005-06 and 6-0 in 1948-49, 1952-53 and 2021-22.

HOME COOKIN'

• Iona's season-opening three-game homestand is a rarity in the 44-year history of the Hynes Center.

• It is the first time since 1999-2000 and sixth time in the history of the building, the Gaels played its first two games at home (1984-85, 1978-79, 1977-78, 1976-77).

• It is only the second time in history the Gaels played three-in-a-row to open the year at the Hynes Center (1984-85).

JR JOSEPH NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

• Sophomore **Nelly Junior Joseph** was the lone representative of the Gaels and was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC First Team by the league's 11 head coaches.

• Junior Joseph is the reigning MAAC Rookie of the Year.

WHO'S BACK?

• Iona returns **10** players from 2020-21 campaign including starters **Berrick JeanLouis** and **Nelly Junior Joseph** and sixth-man **Dylan van Eyck**.

• Sophomore **Ryan Myers** also returns and looks for an elevated role after being a key player off the bench as a rookie.

• The Gaels also return graduate **Colton Cashaw**, senior **Robert Brown**, junior **Osborn Shema** and freshman **Trey James**.

• Walk on juniors **James Carey** and **Parker Weiss** also return for another season in Maroon & Gold.

• The Gaels graduated four student-athletes last season. van Eyck and Cashaw returned for a final season while **Isaiah Ross** and **Asante Gist** moved on to professional careers in the NBA G-League.

WHAT'S NEW?

• Six players made their Iona debut this season including three high-major transfers and three true freshmen.

• American Conference graduate transfers **Elijah Joiner** (Tulsa) and **Tyson Jolly** (SMU) will make an immediate impact in the Gael lineup. Joiner was No. 2 in scoring at Tulsa (11.3 ppg) and led the team with 4.0 apg. Jolly was Third Team All-AAC as a junior in 2019-20, averaging 14.5 ppg before an injury plagued senior campaign limited him to just eight contests.

• ACC transfer **Quinn Slazinski** started eight of Louisville's 20 games last season and averaged 6.2 points and 3.6 rebounds in 21.1 mpg.

• Rookies **Walter Clayton Jr.**, **Joshua Duach** and **Jordan Wildy** will also make their debut.

RICK PITINO ERA YEAR TWO

• Iona College is in its second season under Hall of Fame head coach **Rick Pitino** in 2021-22.

• Coach Pitino was tabbed to lead the program on March 14, 2020 after **Tim Cluess** stepped down for health reasons following the most successful decade in Iona basketball history.

• Coach Pitino spent the prior two seasons Panathinaikos B.C. (PAN-ah-tin-IKE-ohs) in the EuroLeague in Greece.

• The Naismith Hall of Famer begins his 34th year as a head coach of an NCAA Division I program.

• Coach Pitino has led Hawaii, Boston University, Providence, Kentucky, Louisville and Iona to **800** career wins, seven final fours, and two national titles among his numerous career accomplishments.

• The New York native returned home to the Metropolitan area where it all started. Growing up in Manhattan, Pitino starred for the CHSAA's St. Dominic High School on Long Island before his collegiate playing days at UMass and long coaching career.

• He also coached several years with the New York Knicks and Boston Celtics in the NBA.

OPENING NIGHT HEAVYWEIGHTS

- Of the 184 NCAA Division I games on opening night only five featured teams who both played in the 2021 NCAA Tournament.
- The games included: App State at Iona, Mount St. Mary's at Villanova, Texas Southern at Oregon, Cleveland State at BYU, and Kansas vs. Michigan State at Madison Square Garden.

GAELS IN GREECE

- Iona traveled to Greece this summer from August 19-30 and played five exhibition games as part of a summer foreign tour heading into the 2021-22 season.
- The Maroon & Gold took on four high-level teams during the trip, competing against Ionikos, Lavrio, Panathinaikos and Peristeri. All four are members of the top tier Greek Basketball League.
- The Gaels posted a 1-4 record, put a scare into Coach Pitino's former team and EuroLeague participant Panathinaikos and defeated Ionikos in the trips final game.
- Off days in Greece allowed for visiting culturally significant sites in the Athens area and a weekend trip to the island of Spetses.

ROSS, GIST DRAFTED BY NBA G-LEAGUE

- Both of Iona's departing 2021-22 seniors look to continue their basketball careers at the professional level this upcoming season.
- **Isaiah Ross** was the 18th overall pick by the Maine Celtics and was traded to the Santa Cruz Warriors. Santa Cruz is the former team of Gael Great **Scott Machado**.
- **Asante Gist** was drafted by the hometown Westchester Knicks with the third pick of the third round. He played in the NBA Summer League with the Washington Wizards.

2020-21 COVID ISSUES

- Iona College men's basketball faced multiple pauses during the 2020-21 campaign due to COVID-19 issues within the program, including a 51-day layoff from Dec. 23 - Feb. 12. It was the longest layoff in NCAA Division I of the season.
- Four programs experienced gaps in playing time of more than 40 days including the Gaels' MAAC counterpart Canisius.
- It would not be the last pause, as the Gaels faced another 17-day layoff prior to their historic run in the MAAC tournament from Mar. 9-13.
- Iona played just 18 total games and nine in league play in 2020-21.

BUSTING THE (MAAC) BRACKET

- The No. 9 seed never won nor reached the MAAC Championship game in the event's history until this season.
- The previous lowest seed to reach the MAAC final was Fairfield, a No. 8 seed, in 1997.
- Iona is the No. 9 seed for the first time in history.

JR JOSEPH NAMED ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

- Freshman **Nelly Junior Joseph** became the fourth MAAC Rookie of the Year in program history and first since **Schadrac Casimir** in 2015.
- Junior Joseph and Casimir are joined by **Scott Machado** (2009) and **Richie Simmonds** (1985) as MAAC Rookies of the Year from Iona.

ABOUT CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT TITLES

- Iona is the only NCAA Division I program to capture its last five straight completed conference tournament championships and holds the nation's longest active streak.
- Only three programs have won at least six tournament titles in the last decade. Iona's six during the time frame is only eclipsed by Gonzaga (8) and New Mexico State (7).

LET IT RAIN

- After **21 games**, Iona has made a three-pointer in **431** straight and **878** out of its last **880** games.
- In 2019-20, the Gaels eclipsed their previous program record of 385 straight from Jan. 5, 1994 - Dec. 16, 2006.
- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their **1,106** games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

LUCKY 13, SIX CONFERENCES, FIVE TEAMS

- Iona won its league record 13th MAAC Tournament Championship last weekend. The next highest total is five, shared by Siena and Manhattan.
- **Rick Pitino** earned his 13th conference tournament championship in 33 seasons as a Division I head coach.
- Coach Pitino has won championships with Boston University (1983), Kentucky (1992-95, 1996), Louisville (2003, 2005, 2009, 2012-14) and now Iona (2021).
- Rick Pitino is the only coach in NCAA Div. I history to win tournaments in six difference conferences (ECAC North, SEC, Conference USA, Big East, American and MAAC).
- Coach Pitino is also just the third head coach in D-I history to take five different schools to the NCAA tournament, joining Tubby Smith and Lon Kruger.

SIX DECADE CLUB

- With Iona's win at Hofstra in 2020-21, Naismith Hall of Fame head coach **Rick Pitino** joined an exclusive club, becoming the sixth head coach to win a Division I college basketball game in six different decades.
- Coach Pitino won his first game in the 1970s with the University of Hawaii in 1976. His stint at Boston University wrapped around the turn of the 1980s decade, where he also won games with Providence and Kentucky. He spent eight seasons with the Wildcats, all in the 1990s. His 2000s and 2010s victories all came while at the Louisville. His first win at Iona on Dec. 5, 2020, also his first this decade.
- Coach Pitino joined contemporaries **Cliff Ellis**, **Jim Boeheim** and **Mike Krzyzewski** who joined the list last season.
- **Bill Reinhart** (1910s-1960s, Oregon, George Washington) and **Tony Hinkle** (1920s-1970s, Butler) were the lone members prior to the turn of the calendar in January.
- **Phog Allen** of Kanstas lore, came very close— he coached from the 1900s to the 1950s but in the 1910s, his only year at a Div. I school was at Kansas in 1919-20. The Jayhawks won their first four games that season, but the season opener took place on January 6, 1920. Allen remains one of many "five-decadars".

- The MAAC announced its Time Out for Black Lives initiative, aiming to inspire and educate youth, athletes, families and fans.
- Time Out for Black Lives is an interactive website where coaches and student-athletes from MAAC basketball programs contribute their time and resources to read children's books in entertaining videos, all focusing on Black culture, history, music and myths.
- The program is a part of the MAAC's United for Justice campaign announced this summer.
- Iona head coach **Rick Pitino** participated in the effort, reading "*A Nation's Hope: The Story of Boxing Legend Joe Louis*," a story written by Matt De La Pena and illustrated by Kadir Nelson.

- The initiative was brought to the MAAC by Coach Pitino following his experience in Greece where a similar reading program sought to teach English to Greek children (Time Out for English).

RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

- Iona honored the legacy of **Richie Guerin '54** by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.
- Guerin is an Iona College Goal Club (1983), Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.
- He rewrote the basketball record books at Iona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.
- A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.
- Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.
- In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

GAEL GREATS

- In addition to Naismith Hall of Famer **Richie Guerin '54**, here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:
- **Jim Valvano** - legendary head coach at Iona from 1975-80 who "Dared To Dream" to win a national championship with the Gaels and finally did in 1983, albeit with North Carolina State. Succumbed to cancer in 1993 eight weeks after an impassioned speech at the ESPY Awards that year which in which he announced creation of The V Foundation for Cancer Research and its motto, "Don't Give Up... Don't Ever Give Up."
 - **Jeff Ruland '91** - All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with

the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.

• **Tim Cluess** - head coach from 2010-2020. At the helm during one the Gaels' most successful decades in program history. Cluess won 199 games in nine seasons on the sideline including six NCAA appearances, five MAAC tournament championships, and four MAAC regular season titles. He is the all-time MAAC leader in MAAC tournament victories.

• **Pat Kennedy** - head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle.

• **Warren Isaac '65** - Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.

• **Tim Welsh** - head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.

• **Kevin Willard** - Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big East's Seton Hall. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.

• **Steve Burt '84 & Steve Burt '06** - All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burt, the father, had a four-season NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.

• **Sean Green '91** - Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.

• **Scott Machado '12** - The last Gael to appear in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. Played the majority 2018-19 season in the NBA G-League for the South Bay Lakers and played four games with the Los Angeles Lakers. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in Australia.

• **Bob Santini '53** - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

NOTABLE ALUMNI (ATHLETICS/POP CULTURE)

• **Brendan Malone '62** - longtime NBA assistant coach, last with the Detroit Pistons from 2014-16.

• **Don McLean** - Singer-songwriter noted most famous for his 1971 single "American Pie".

• **Dennis Leonard** - Kansas City Royals Hall of Famer and 12-year MLB veteran who won 20 games on three occasions from 1977-80. He was inducted in May 2015 into the New York Baseball Hall of Fame.

• **Kyle Flood '93** - Former head football coach at Rutgers, current OC and OL coach at Texas.

• **Maggie Timoney '89** - The Iona women's basketball Hall of Famer recently _became the first female CEO of Heineken USA.

• **Jason Motte** - Major League Baseball relief pitcher recorded the final out of the 2011 World Series with the world champion St. Louis Cardinals. Has also appeared in Major League games with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies and Atlanta Braves.

• **Leonard Korir '12** - a two time NCAA track and field champion while at Iona, Korir represented Team USA in the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in the 10,000-meter event. He is currently ranked as the top American marathon runner on WorldAthletics.org.

• **Amanda Saccomanno '13** - World Wrestling Entertainment's (WWE) Mandy Rose, competes on the SmackDown brand.

IONA PERFORMERS

- Nelly Junior Joseph led Iona with 17 points in just 15 minutes of play. He was 7-for-9 from the field, and 3-of-3 from the charity stripe and grabbed six rebounds.
- Ryan Myers posted 15 points, three rebounds and two assists. He was 5-for-9 from the field and hit all three three-point attempts.
- Elijah Joiner added 13 points, three assists and two boards. He did most of his damage from the free-throw line converting 11-of-13 attempts.
- Tyson Jolly had 11 points and a team-best eight rebounds. He stuffed the stat sheet with three assists, a steal and a block.
- Dylan van Eyck also added 11 points with three rebounds, four blocks, an assist and a steal. He converted all three shot attempts and has made nine of his last 10 dating back to last Sunday at Quinnipiac.
- Quinn Slazinski posted nine points including a team-high seven in the first half. He also added four rebounds, two assists and a steal in 16 minutes on the floor.
- Osborn Shema played 25 strong minutes in relief of a foul-plagued Junior Joseph, with five points, five rebounds three assists and two blocks.

TEAM STATS

- Iona out shot Saint Peter's 51.9% - 46.4%. Both teams shot well in the second half with the Gaels converting 17-of-30 attempts (56.7%) and Saint Peter's making 15-of-30 (50.0%).

- The Maroon & Gold's 22-12 rebounding advantage in the second half led to a 37-30 lead for the game over the MAAC's leading rebounding team in terms of margin heading into the contest. The Gaels had a 16-6 advantage in second chance points.
- Iona led 18-14 on assists and committed one less turnover in the contest with 14. Both teams took better care of the ball in the second half. After 19 combined turnovers in the first 20 minutes, only 10 were committed in the final 20.

NOTABLE NUGGETS

- The win was Iona's 30th in 39 tries under Coach Pitino. The best 39-game start by a head coach to start his tenure at Iona. Other Iona coaches with a .500 mark in their first 39 contests include: Tim Welsh (28-11), Tim Cluess (26-13), Jim McDermott (24-15), Pat Kennedy (23-16), Gary Brokaw (21-18), and Jeff Ruland (20-19).
- Iona has won seven straight games, the longest stretch since Coach Pitino's arrival last season and longest since a 10-game winning streak heading into the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Iona is the sixth team to win at least 10 games to start the MAAC season and first since Siena won its first 14 in 2019-10 in route to a 17-1 finish and regular season conference title.
- It was the first time Iona and Saint Peter's squared off since the 2020 MAAC Quarterfinal round. The game was one of the final NCAA contests completed before the COVID-19 pandemic forced the cancellation of the remainder of the conference tournament and entire NCAA tournament.

Massachusetts '74 - Second Season

Naismith Hall of Famer Rick Pitino was named head basketball coach of Iona College on March 14, 2020. Coach Pitino has taken four different programs to the NCAA tournament and coached two national championship teams. During his 33 previous seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rick Pitino held a **800-280** overall record and a 54-20 record in the NCAA Tournament. He became the first coach to take three different schools to the NCAA Final Four and first coach to win an NCAA Championship at two different schools. Pitino holds the third highest winning percentage in NCAA Tournament games (.740) among all active coaches.

Pitino, who has a stellar reputation for success on the court and a dedication to student-athlete academic success, has served as head coach of the University of Louisville (2001-2017, winning the 2013 NCAA Championship), University of Kentucky (1989-1997, winning the 1996 NCAA Championship), Providence College (1985-1987), Boston University (1978-1983) and Hawaii (last six games 1975-1976). And, while often choosing to do so anonymously, Rick has served as a charitable benefactor for a broad spectrum of worthy causes.

- Founded in 1940, Iona is inspired by the legacy of Blessed Edmund Rice and the Christian Brothers, embodying opportunity, justice and the liberating power of education.
- Iona's beautiful 45-acre campus in New Rochelle, N.Y., is only two miles from the Long Island Sound and 20 miles north of Midtown Manhattan.
- Iona College is a small Catholic liberal arts college that has emerged as an anomaly in higher education, with new-student enrollment spiking over 30 percent in two years (despite being on the front lines of COVID-19 when the virus first hit New Rochelle in March 2020).
- Iona was awarded the #20 spot in U.S. News & World Report's list of "Most Innovative Schools" in the north region.
- The College recently acquired the 28-acre campus of Concordia College in nearby Bronxville, N.Y.
- With the support of a \$20 million gift from NewYork-Presbyterian, Iona has established the NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences on the new Iona Bronxville campus, developing a premier new school in collaboration with New York's #1 hospital.
- Iona has started construction on a vibrant new green space in the heart of campus, which will be done by the spring of 2022, called the "Murphy Green." It will be a lively outdoor landscape where students can enjoy a variety of social, recreational, academic and artistic activities.
- Iona College recently launched its new Club Sports program, which is geared toward those with an interest in organized sports outside of Iona's rigorous Division I Athletics program. This program also includes an eSports club, set to compete in Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.
- Tradition: Iona's Pipe Band performs at major campus events, such as Homecoming and Commencement, and even leads the College's march up Fifth Avenue in the New York City St. Patrick's Day parade. - A Bronx native and first-generation college student, Carey began his Iona presidency in July 2019.
- Just a few months into his leadership, President Carey was among the first to contend with the COVID-19 pandemic. He swiftly closed campus in March due to Iona's proximity to the New Rochelle outbreak, shifting all learning to online platforms. Pushing to innovate and lead through the pandemic, Iona was also one of the first in the nation to reopen.

- Propelling the College on a path of innovation, President Carey has since overseen the launch of Iona's new brand, new nursing program, and two new undergraduate programs in entrepreneurship and entrepreneurial leadership. He has also presided over the grand reopening of the newly renovated LaPenta School of Business, in addition to the opening of the Hynes Institute for Entrepreneurship & Innovation.
