The Iona University men's basketball team (3-2, 1-0 MAAC) continues a three-game homestand at the Hynes Center when it hosts Canisius (2-5, 0-1) Sunday afternoon. Tip-off is slated for 1 p.m. in New Rochelle on ESPN+.

IONA VS. CANISIUS - SERIES HISTORY

- The Gaels and Griffs meet for the 81st time in history with Iona holding a 47-33 advantage.
- Iona has won seven straight and 14 of the last 18 meetings.
- The Maroon & Gold is 26-7 on its home floor.

SCOUTING CANISIUS (2-5, 0-1 MAAC)

- Canisius enters today's game with a 2-5 record following three straight hard fought defeats on the road.
- The Griffs are 1-18 on the road in the last two seasons.
- Three players average 10+ points led by **Jamir Moultrie's** 13.6 ppg. Moultrie leads with 22 3FG, connecting on a 44.9% clip.
- Tahj Staveskie** averages 13.0 ppg and a team-best 3.7 apg.
- Jordan Henderson** has also posted 13.0 ppg. He's No. 2 with 2.7 apg and 15 3FG.
- Xavier Long** leads with 6.0 rpg.
- Canisius leads the MAAC with 11.1 3FG/g.
- The Griffs were selected to finish 11th in the MAAC this season.

GAELS IN MAAC REGULAR SEASON PLAY

- Since the inception of the MAAC in the 1981-82 season, Iona has compiled a 421-255 (.623) record in regular season play.
- The Gaels' 420 wins and .622 win percentage are the highest of any current MAAC member.
- The Gaels became the first team to reach 400 wins with its win at Rider on Dec. 19, 2020.
- Iona is currently 89 wins ahead of Siena, the No. 2 team on the list.

GAELS IN MAAC PLAY AT HOME

The Gaels finished 10-0 at home in MAAC games in 2021-22, setting a new program record. Iona is 13-1 under head coach **Rick Pitino**. The 10 wins surpassed the previous program mark reached in 1997-98, 2013-14 and 2014-15. Iona is **93-22 (.809)** in MAAC contests at the Hynes Center in its last **115** games. The Gaels overall record in home conference games is an outstanding **238-94 (.717)**.

JR JOSEPH, CLAYTON JR. NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

- Junior **Nelly Junior Joseph** and **Walter Clayton Jr.** were Iona's representatives on the Preseason All-MAAC Teams selected by the league's 11 head coaches.
- Junior Joseph was picked on the first team while Clayton Jr. was on the second.

TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK

- Through its first five games and Thursday's contests, Iona is No. 4 in the NCAA with just 8.8 turnovers per game. New Hampshire (8.5/g), Stetson (8.5) and Notre Dame (8.7) are ahead of the Gaels.
- The Gaels also rank No. 8 in the country with a 1.68-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Iona has committed less than 10 turnovers in four of its first five contests.**

BLOCK PARTY

- Nelly Junior Joseph matched a career-high with six blocks at Hofstra in the second game of the season.
- With 10 blocks in four games, his 2.0 bpg average ranks 33rd in the NCAA this season and No. 2 in the MAAC.

EARLY SIGNEE

- Izaiah Pasha** signed an NLI to play for the Gaels next fall and is the first recruit for the Maroon & Gold for the 2023-24 season.
- Pasha hails from Harrisburg, PA and attends Cardinal O'Hara High School in the suburbs of Philadelphia.
- A 6-5 scoring wing, he thrived at both guard spots as a junior after playing at the wing position in his first two scholastic seasons.
- He chose Iona over offers from Delaware, Xavier, VCU, George Washington, Towson, St. Joseph's and La Salle, among others.

LOU HENSON WATCH LIST

- Nelly Junior Joseph** is the MAAC's lone representative on the 2022-23 Lou Henson National Player of the Year award early season watch list.
- CollegeInsider.com listed 50 players to the watch list for the top mid-major player in Division I.
- While no other MAAC players appear on the list, the Gaels non-conference slate features four including: Hofstra's Aaron Estrada, Penn's Jordan Dingle, Princeton's Tosan Evbuomwan and potentially Seattle's Cameron Tyson

ABOUT THAT SCHEDULE

- Iona's 2022-23 non-conference schedule ranks sixth-hardest based on average NET ranking of Division I opponents.**
- The top 10 lists includes: Saint Mary's (72.4), Seton Hall (82.8), UT-Arlington (87.8), Alabama (91.6), Middle Tennessee (92.0), Iona (101.9), Michigan State (103.6), Texas Southern (107.6), North Carolina A&T (114.7) and Auburn (117.4).

GAELS PICKED FIRST IN MAAC PRESEASON POLL

- For the second straight year, Iona selected to finish first in the MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll following a regular season championship in 2021-22.
- The Gaels have captured a league best 11 regular season championships in 41 MAAC seasons.

WHO'S BACK?

- Iona returns **seven** players from 2021-22 campaign including starters **Berrick JeanLouis**, **Nelly Junior Joseph** and **Quinn Slazinski**.
- Sophomore **Walter Clayton Jr.** also returns and looks for an elevated role after being a key player off the bench and an MAAC All-Rookie Team selection last year.
- Senior **Osborn Shema** will see minutes in Iona's front-court. When healthy, Shema is an impact performer on the floor.
- Senior captain **Parker Weiss** returns for his fourth season earning a scholarship for his final year.
- Walk-on senior **James Carey** rounds out the Gael returning squad.
- Three of Iona's four graduates from last season are playing pro ball this year: **Dylan van Eyck** (Italy), **Tyson Jolly** (G-League) and **Elijah Joiner** (Cyprus).

WHAT'S NEW?

- Seven players make their Iona debut this season including three transfers and four true freshmen.
- Junior **Daniss Jenkins** comes to Iona via JUCO Odessa College and D-I Pacific. Jenkins was an All-WCC honorable mention selection as a sophomore and All-Rookie as a freshman.
- Sophomore **Anton Brookshire** spent last season in the SEC and Missouri. Brookshire was one of the top scholastic players in Missouri as a high school performer.
- Sophomore **Michael Jefferson** helped lead Northwest Florida State to a JUCO national title while looking to bolster his recruiting profile after graduating high school
- Texas phenom **Crux Davis** is joined by Bronx-based Our Savior Lutheran teammates **Sadiku Ibine Ayo** and **Silas Sunday** and Colorado Prep standout **Keither Florence** as Iona's freshman class.

CLASS OF 2022 PROS

- Three of Iona's departing 2021-22 seniors look to continue their basketball careers at the professional level this upcoming season.
- Tyson Jolly** was the 32nd overall pick by the Greensboro Swarm, the G-League affiliate of the Charlotte Hornets. He is the third Gael in two seasons to be selected in the draft.
- Dylan van Eyck** signed with Chiusi in the Italian Serie A2 and **Elijah Joiner** with E.N. Paralimni in the Cypriot OPAP Basket League.

MID MAJOR POLLING

- Iona fell to spot to No. 15 on the CollegeInsider.com Men's Mid-Major Top 25 in the Week 2 release on Nov. 21.

KING OF THE HILL, TOP OF THE LIST

- No team among the 14 NYC Metropolitan Area Division I basketball programs within 30 miles of the center of NY College basketball, Madison Square Garden has won more games than Iona College in the 27 seasons (505; Hofstra #2, 481).
- Over the last decade-plus, Iona's 251 wins and .640 win percentage are also the best in both categories. (Seton Hall, 230 wins; .582 win pct.)
- Since 1995-96, the Maroon & Gold hold the lead in wins (504), 14 more than Hofstra, 36 more than No. 3 Seton Hall and the top win percentage (.593).
- Iona's 11 postseason appearances (seven NCAA, three NIT, one CIT) since 2010-11 are the most during the time frame, nearly twice as many Seton Hall (5 NCAA, 1 NIT) and St. John's (three NCAA, two NIT).

REGULAR SEASON CHAMPS

- Last season Iona claimed its MAAC-record 11th regular season championship.
- Iona last won the regular season title in 2018-19 and has earned five in the last 11 seasons.
- The Gaels regular season titles have come in 1982-83, 1984-85, 1995-96, 1996-97, 1997-98, 2000-01, 2011-12, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2018-19 and 2021-22.

20/20 VISION

- Iona has recorded 23 20+ win seasons in the 77-year history of the program.
- Last season was the 10th 20+ win campaign since 2009-10, spanning the last 13 seasons.
- Iona's has won at least 25 games for the seventh time including four in the last 12 seasons.

13-0 AT HYNES

- Iona played to a perfect 13-0 overall and 10-0 in MAAC play record at the Hynes Center in 2021-22.
- It was the 14th undefeated home campaign in program history.
- The Maroon & Gold accomplished the feat just five times in the history of the Hynes/Mulcahy Center: 1979-80 (13-0), 1984-85 (14-0), 1997-98 (12-0), 2014-15 (13-0), 2021-22 (13-0)
- The Gaels were also undefeated in MAAC play at home the latter four seasons.
- Following its win over Niagara, the Gaels have won 17 straight home games and are 19-2 at the Hynes Center under Coach Pitino.

PITINO TREE

- Last week, Santa Clara was the first of three non-conference opponents for the Gaels where they take on a team whose head coach played for or coached with **Rick Pitino**.
- Santa Clara's **Herb Sendek** served as a graduate assistant for Coach Pitino at Providence from 1985-87 and assistant at Kentucky from 1989-93. He went on to be the head coach at Miami (OH), North Carolina State and Arizona State before his current position at Santa Clara.
- Saint Louis' **Travis Ford** was a three-year point guard for Coach Pitino at Kentucky from 1991-94. He is in his 23rd season as a Division I head coach having led Eastern Kentucky, UMass, and Oklahoma State prior to SLU.
- New Mexico's **Richard Pitino** was on his father's coaching staff at Louisville from 2007-09 and 2011-12. He has been a Division I head coach since 2012 at Florida International and Minnesota before his current gig.

17 MAAC WINS

- Iona was the sixth team to earn 17 or more MAAC victories in a single-season. The last team to do such was Monmouth five seasons ago (18 wins, 2016-17).
- Iona's matched its single-season record of 17 set in back-to-back campaigns in 2013-14 and 2014-15.
- The six teams that have won 17 games, include Iona three times, Monmouth twice (2015-16, 2016-17) and Siena (2009-10).
- Monmouth's 18 wins in 2016-17 is the MAAC record.

RICK PITINO ERA YEAR THREE

- Iona College is in its third season under Hall of Fame head coach **Rick Pitino** in 2022-23.
- Coach Pitino was tabbed to lead the program on March 14, 2020 after **Tim Cluess** stepped down for health reasons following the most successful decade in Iona basketball history.
- Coach Pitino spent the prior two seasons Panathinaikos B.C. (PAN-ah-tin-IKE-ohs) in the EuroLeague in Greece.
- The Naismith Hall of Famer begins his 34th year as a head coach of an NCAA Division I program.
- Coach Pitino has led Hawaii, Boston University, Providence, Kentucky, Louisville and Iona to **807** career wins, seven final fours, and two national titles among his numerous career accomplishments.
- The New York native returned home to the Metropolitan area where it all started. Growing up in Manhattan, Pitino starred for the CHSAA's St. Dominic High School on Long Island before his collegiate playing days at UMass and long coaching career.
- He also coached several years with the New York Knicks and Boston Celtics in the NBA.

LET IT RAIN

- After **five games**, Iona has made a three-pointer in **448** straight and **895** out of its last **897** games.
- In 2019-20, the Gaels eclipsed their previous program record of 385 straight from Jan. 5, 1994 - Dec. 16, 2006.
- The Gaels have failed to hit a three-pointer in just 18 of their **1,123** games played since the line was adopted for the 1986-87 season.

IONA IN SEASON OPENERS

- The Gaels have now posted a 52-24 record in their first game of the season since 1945.
- Iona opened the season at home for the second straight season and the third time in last eight seasons in 2022-23.
- The Maroon & Gold is 17-2 all-time in season openers at the Hynes Center and 37-5 all-time, earning six straight wins.

LUCKY 13, SIX CONFERENCES, FIVE TEAMS

- Iona won its league record 13th MAAC Tournament Championship in 2020-21. The next highest total is five, shared by Siena and Manhattan.
- **Rick Pitino** has earned 13 conference tournament championships in 34 seasons as a Division I head coach.
- Coach Pitino has won championships with Boston University (1983), Kentucky (1992-95, 1996), Louisville (2003, 2005, 2009, 2012-14) and Iona (2021).
- Rick Pitino is the only coach in NCAA Div. I history to win tournaments in six difference conferences (ECAC North, SEC, Conference USA, Big East, American and MAAC).
- Coach Pitino is also just the third head coach in D-I history to take five different schools to the NCAA tournament, joining Tubby Smith and Lon Kruger.

SIX DECADE CLUB

- With Iona's win at Hofstra in 2020-21, Naismith Hall of Fame head coach **Rick Pitino** joined an exclusive club, becoming the sixth head coach to win a Division I college basketball game in six different decades.
- Coach Pitino won his first game in the 1970s with the University of Hawaii in 1976. His stint at Boston University wrapped around the turn of the 1980s decade, where he also won games with Providence and Kentucky. He spent eight seasons with the Wildcats, all in the 1990s. His 2000s and 2010s victories all came while at the Louisville. His first win at Iona on Dec. 5, 2020, also his first this decade.
- Coach Pitino joined contemporaries **Cliff Ellis**, **Jim Boeheim** and **Mike Krzyzewski** who joined the list last season.
- **Bill Reinhart** (1910s-1960s, Oregon, George Washington) and **Tony Hinkle** (1920s-1970s, Butler) were the lone members prior to the turn of the calendar in January.
- **Phog Allen** of Kansas lore, came very close— he coached from the 1900s to the 1950s but in the 1910s, his only year at a Div. I school was at Kansas in 1919-20. The Jayhawks won their first four games that season, but the season opener took place on January 6, 1920. Allen remains one of many "five-decadars".

- The program is a part of the MAAC's United for Justice campaign.
- Iona head coach **Rick Pitino** participated in the effort, reading "A Nation's Hope: The Story of Boxing Legend Joe Louis," a story written by Matt De La Pena and illustrated by Kadir Nelson.
- Junior Nelly Junior Joseph read "Why Hippias Live In Water," a Nigerian myth recounted by Elphinstone Dayrell.

- The initiative was brought to the MAAC by Coach Pitino following his experience in Greece where a similar reading program sought to teach English to Greek children (Time Out for English).

RICHIE GUERIN'S #14 HANGS IN THE RAFTERS

- Iona honored the legacy of **Richie Guerin '54** by retiring his number 14 on Jan. 31, 2014 the first ever in school history.
- Guerin is an Iona College Goal Club (1983), Marine Corps Sports (2004), and Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame (2013) inductee who starred for the Maroon & Gold from 1951-1954.
- He rewrote the basketball record books at Iona, scoring 1,375 points and graduated as the leading scorer in school history.
- A two-time All-Metropolitan selection with the Gaels, he scored a then school-record 40 points against John Carroll in 1954 and was the first Gael to score 40 or more points in a game.
- Following his playing days at Iona, Guerin played with the National Basketball Association's New York Knicks from 1956-1963 and was a player-coach of the St. Louis/Atlanta Hawks franchise for nine years.
- In 13 years as a professional player, Guerin accumulated 14,676 points (17.3 per game), 4,278 rebounds (5.1 per game), and 4,211 assists (5.0 per game) over 848 games.

Gael Greats

- In addition to Naismith Hall of Famer **Richie Guerin '54**, here are additional significant names in Iona basketball history:
- **Jim Valvano** - legendary head coach at Iona from 1975-80 who "Dared To Dream" to win a national championship with the Gaels and finally did in 1983, albeit with North Carolina State. Succumbed to cancer in 1993 eight weeks after an impassioned speech at the ESPY Awards that year which in which he announced creation of The V Foundation for Cancer Research and its motto, "Don't Give Up... Don't Ever Give Up."
 - **Jeff Ruland '91** - All-American during his time at Iona and, two-time NBA All-Star with

the Washington Bullets, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. Following his career, returned to Iona and served as head coach from 1998-2007 where he won three MAAC Championships.

- **Tim Cluess** - head coach from 2010-2020. At the helm during one the Gaels' most successful decades in program history. Cluess won 199 games in nine seasons on the sideline including six NCAA appearances, five MAAC tournament championships, and four MAAC regular season titles. He is the all-time MAAC leader in MAAC tournament victories.
- **Pat Kennedy** - head coach from 1980-86. Went on to coach at Florida State, DePaul, Montana, and Towson following a highly successful tenure in New Rochelle.
- **Warren Isaac '65** - Iona's only 50-point scorer, Isaac played six seasons in Europe following his tenure at Iona. A New York City school legend, Isaac started for Power Memorial paving the way for NBA Hall of Famer Kareem Abdul-Jabbar a 1965 graduate of the high school.
- **Tim Welsh** - head coach from 1995-98 who went on to coach in the Big East with Providence for 10 seasons. Currently an ESPN college basketball analyst. Holds the highest career winning percentage ever at Iona.
- **Kevin Willard** - Iona coach from 2007-10, now head coach at Big East's Seton Hall. Helped turn around a program which won two games in the season prior to his arrival to 20 wins in his final season in Maroon & Gold.
- **Steve Burt '84 & Steve Burt '06** - All-time NCAA father/son scoring leaders, both netting over 2,000 career points. Burt, the father, had a four-season NBA career and most notably appeared off the bench for the Phoenix Suns in the 1992 NBA Playoffs. He was inducted into the prestigious NYC Basketball Hall of Fame this past fall. Burt, the son, continues to play professionally in Europe.
- **Sean Green '91** - Played 84 NBA games over three seasons for the Indiana Pacers, Philadelphia 76ers and Utah Jazz from 1991-94. Currently a high school basketball coach in Southern California.
- **Scott Machado '12** - The last Gael to appear in an NBA game. Machado played in regular season NBA contests in 2012-13 with the Houston Rockets and postseason with the Golden State Warriors. Played the majority 2018-19 season in the NBA G-League for the South Bay Lakers and played four games with the Los Angeles Lakers. The MAAC & Iona's all-time assist leader. He currently plays professionally in Australia.
- **Bob Santini '53** - Iona's first NBA player, appeared in four games with the New York Knicks in 1955-56.

- **Amanda Saccomanno '13** - World Wrestling Entertainment's (WWE) Mandy Rose, competes on the SmackDown brand.

- **Ignacio Maganto** - was selected by the LA Galaxy with the 21st pick in the first round of the 2015 MLS SuperDraft, the first Major League Soccer draft pick in Iona history. Maganto scored his first MLS goal with the Galaxy in the spring of 2015.
- **Mariano Rivera III '15** - Earned his degree in May 2015 and was selected in the fourth round by the Washington Nationals.

IONA UNIVERSITY NOTES OF INTEREST

- Founded in 1940, Iona is inspired by the legacy of Blessed Edmund Rice and the Christian Brothers, embodying opportunity, justice and the liberating power of education.
- Building on its proud legacy, Iona officially became a University on July 1, 2022, turning the page to the next chapter ahead.
- With a total enrollment of nearly 4,000 students and an alumni base of over 50,000 around the world, Iona is a diverse community of learners and scholars.
- Iona University is a small Catholic liberal arts school that has emerged as an anomaly in higher education, with new-student enrollment spiking over 30 percent in three years.
- Iona students can expect small class sizes, engaged professors and a wide range of undergraduate and graduate programs within the School of Arts & Science, LaPenta School of Business NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences and Hynes Institute for Entrepreneurship & Innovation.
- Iona now has two campuses in Westchester County, N.Y., just north of New York City. Iona's beautiful 45-acre campus in New Rochelle, N.Y., and new 28-acre campus in Bronxville, N.Y., are both just 30 minutes via Metro-North train to Midtown Manhattan.
- With the support of a \$20 million gift from NewYork-Presbyterian, Iona has established the NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences on its new Bronxville campus, developing a premier new school in collaboration with one of the nation's top hospitals.
- The flagship building of Iona's new Bronxville campus has been named the Kelly Center for Health Sciences thanks to benefactors Al and Peggy Kelly. Both are double alumni and longtime Iona basketball fans; Al Kelly is the CEO of Visa.

- Iona also continues to beautify its New Rochelle campus, where it opened a vibrant new green space called the "Murphy Green" in the heart of campus.
- It pays to go to Iona: 92 percent of Iona graduates are employed full-time or enrolled in graduate school within six months of graduation. Iona is also in the top 4 percent nationwide for its long-term return on investment, according to Georgetown University's Center on Education and the Workforce.
- Iona is adding two new Division I Varsity programs next year – men's lacrosse and women's acrobatics & tumbling.
- Iona also continues to expand its Club Sports program, which is geared toward those with an interest in organized sports outside of Iona's rigorous Division I Athletics program.
- Iona's esports club won the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in Rocket League last year.
- Tradition: Iona's world renowned Pipe Band performs at major campus events, and even leads the University's march up Fifth Avenue in the New York City St. Patrick's Day parade.
- Iona hired Hall of Fame men's basketball coach Rick Pitino in March 2020; he is eager to claim the team's 14th MAAC Championship and go further in the NCAA Tournament than ever before!
- Members of the Iona community are known as Gaels, who are people with Irish-Gaelic ancestry.
- Notable Iona alumni include Alfred F. Kelly Jr., CEO of Visa Inc.; Margaret C. Timoney, CEO of HEINEKEN USA; and musician Don McLean, most famous for his song "American Pie."



PRESIDENT SEAMUS CAREY, Ph.D.

- Seamus Carey, Ph.D., serves as the ninth president of Iona University.
- A Bronx native and first-generation college student, Carey began his Iona presidency in July 2019.
- Just a few months into his leadership, President Carey was among the first to contend with the COVID-19 pandemic. He swiftly closed campus in March due to Iona's proximity to the New Rochelle outbreak, shifting all learning to online platforms.
- Pushing to innovate and lead through the pandemic, Iona was also one of the first in the nation to resume in-person classes in August 2020.

- Propelling the University on a path of innovation, President Carey has since overseen the school's growth and expansion to include the acquisition of a new second campus in Bronxville, the launch of the NewYork-Presbyterian Iona School of Health Sciences and new programs inside and outside the classroom.
- President Carey also successfully led the transition to become Iona University, reflecting both the strength and diversity of its academic programs.
- New student enrollment is up over 30% under President Carey's leadership.



WHAT IS A GAEL?

- The symbol of Iona University's athletic teams is the popular Gael. A Gael is anyone of Irish-Gaelic ancestry, consistent with the Irish tradition of Iona.
- The University was founded in 1940 by the Congregation of Christian Brothers, commonly known as the Irish Christian Brothers.
- The Gael, which is depicted as a spunky character, provides Iona with a nickname consistent with the school motto, certa bonum certamen ("fight the good fight") and personifies strength.

Massachusetts '74 - Third Season

Naismith Hall of Famer Rick Pitino was named head basketball coach of Iona College on March 14, 2020. Coach Pitino has taken four different programs to the NCAA tournament and coached two national championship teams. During his 34 previous seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rick Pitino held a **810-287** overall record and a 54-20 record in the NCAA Tournament. He became the first coach to take three different schools to the NCAA Final Four and first coach to win an NCAA Championship at two different schools. Pitino holds the third highest winning percentage in NCAA Tournament games (.740) among all active coaches.

Pitino, who has a stellar reputation for success on the court and a dedication to student-athlete academic success, has served as head coach of the University of Louisville (2001-2017, winning the 2013 NCAA Championship), University of Kentucky (1989-1997, winning the 1996 NCAA Championship), Providence College (1985-1987), Boston University (1978-1983) and Hawaii (last six games 1975-1976). And, while often choosing to do so anonymously, Rick has served as a charitable benefactor for a broad spectrum of worthy causes.

IONA PERFORMERS

- Daniss Jenkins shot 12-for-18 from the field and was a perfect 3-for-3 from distance and 4-for-4 from the line. He added a team-best five assists, three blocks and three steals to go along with four rebounds and zero turnovers.
- Walter Clayton Jr. had 13 points in 21 minutes, shooting 5-for-8 from the field and 3-for-3 from the charity stripe.
- Nelly Junior Joseph posted a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double in 21 minutes before fouling out for the first time since his rookie campaign with just under seven minutes to play in the contest.
- Osborn Shema earned the start, scored seven points, grabbed seven rebounds and blocked two shots, filling in for his injured classmate Quinn Slazinski.
- Senior Berrick Jeanlouis had five points, four rebounds and three blocks and matched Jenkins with a +26 +/- scoring margin to lead the Gaels.
