## IONA TRAVELS TO POUGHKEEPSIE FOR MATCHUP WITH MARIST



The Gaels wrap up a short two-game road trip upstate against the Marist Red Foxes on Monday night. The Gaels are still looking for their first conference win and the Red Foxes, winners of three straight, are hoping to stay hot.

### SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Junior transfer **Morgan Rachu** is averaging a team-best 11.5 PPG; she is among the top-15 in the MAAC in scoring.
- Iona has struggled to score, but defensively they have been solid this season. Particularly, its 3PT FG defense has good, limiting opponents to just over 30%.
- Iona boasts eight newcomers to the roster; five freshmen and three transfers. It lost its top four scorers from last season.
- The Gaels were voted 10th in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

### SCOUTING THE RED FOXES

- Junior **Rebekah Hand** paces the Marist offense, averaging 17.4 PPG. Hand has scored in double-figures in 28 straight contests, dating back to last season.
- The Red Foxes boast the top scoring offense in the MAAC and own the second highest point differential in the conference.
- Marist defeated Siena last time out, using a 29 point third quarter to down the Saints. The Red Foxes matched a season-best with 24 assists.
- Head coach **Brian Giorgis** is the all-time winningest coach in team history. He has transformed the program and has been named the MAAC Coach of the Year seven times across his 17 seasons at Marist.

# Billi CHAMBERS

## Head Coach

## Hofstra '03 - Sixth Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her sixth season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

Iona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

Last year the Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country. Rookie Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

Through her first five years leading the Iona program, Chambers holds a 84-74 (.532) overall record.

During her five years at the helm of the Maroon & Gold, four student-athletes have earned All-MAAC First Team honors; Damika Martinez (2014, 15), Joy Adams (2013, 14, 15), Lizarazu (2016, 17), and Alexis Lewis (2017). Martinez was named the MAAC Player of the Year in both her junior and senior year.

Aaliyah Robinson (2014) and Alexis Lewis (2016) each earned MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors. Toyosi Abiola (2018) was the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year.

**NOTABLE NUGGETS**

- The Gaels made just 11 field goals in the loss. Offensively, only two players for the Maroon & Gold made more than one shot attempt.
- Iona's bench was outscored 31-10. Manhattan also scored 21 points off of turnovers compared to Iona's three.
- Lesko drew five charges in the loss. The redshirt sophomore drew two each in the second and third quarters.
- The 33 points scored is the Gaels' lowest point total offensively this year. Iona's 13 points scored at the half is its lowest point total scored in any one half this season.
- Lesko led the way offensively, scoring a team-high 12 points. It marks the ninth time in her career she has scored in double-figures and it is just the second time this season the Harrisburg, PA native has led the offensive unit in scoring.
- The Jaspers now lead the all-time series 49-32; coach Chambers is now 7-5 vs. Manhattan.

- Founded in 1940, Iona College is a private Catholic liberal arts college of approximately 3,800 undergraduate and graduate students, with professional and pre-professional programs in business as well as arts & sciences.
- Located in New Rochelle, N.Y., 20 minutes northwest of Midtown Manhattan, and also offers graduate programs in Rockland County, N.Y., and Manhattan.

- A "hot" school -- three of the largest freshman classes in the last decade started the last three years.

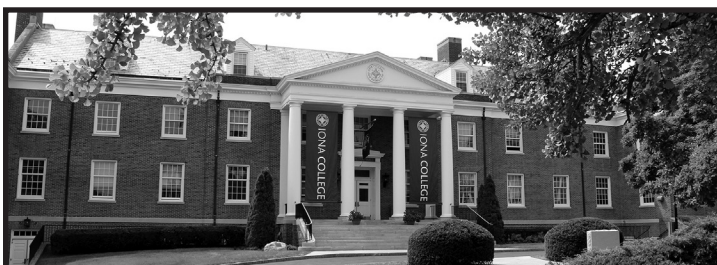


## President Joseph (Joe) Nyre, Ph.D.
