IONA WELCOMES DUQUESNE FOR 2019-20 HOME-OPENER



The Iona Gaels earned a season-opening win at Winthrop last Saturday, the program's first since 2016. The Maroon & Gold christen the newly renovated Hynes Athletics Center by welcoming Duguesne for a Friday night matchup in New Rochelle.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona returns 11 players to its roster for the 2019-20 season, including 7 players who appeared in 20+ games in 2018-19.
- Sophomore point guard Juana Camilion was voted to the MAAC All-Rookie Team last vear and earned Preseason All-MAAC Third Team distinction this season.
- long welcomes five newcomers: four freshmen and one transfer. The Gaels roster is comprised of 10 underclassmen.
- The Gaels were voted 9th in the 2019-20 MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

SCOUTING THE DUKES

- Duquesne graduated its top three scorers from last season, but return four players who have started a significant amount of games.
- The Dukes led the A-10 in assists, assists per game, blocks, blocks per game and freethrow percentage a season ago.
- Duquesne earned its first win of the season on Sunday, defeating the Manhattan Jaspers, 76-65, in Riverdale.
- The Dukes return nine players from 2018-19 and welcome four newcomers to the roster for the 2019-20 campaign.
- Duquesne was voted ninth in the 2019-20 A-10 Women's Basketball Preseason Poll.

Billi CHAMBERS

Head Coach Hofstra '03 - Seventh Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her seventh season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

lona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

After an 0-3 start to the year, Iona defeated George Washington at the Hynes Center midway through November. A 20-game slide would follow, spanning non-conference and conference play across a four-month period. The Gaels continued to progress though as a unit under Chambers, and it showed when they topped Monmouth on the road in February.

Iona would enter the MAAC Tournament on a high note, toppling Saint Peter's on the road in the regular season finale and maintaining the 10 seed in the league postseason. In the First Round matchup against the tournament host Siena, the Gaels pulled off the upset over the No. 7 seed, 75-64. Rider would end Iona's season the next day, but the foundation for a successful next season had been laid.

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch, being named the MAAC Rookie of the Year unanimously. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led lona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.



NOTABLE NUGGETS

- lona's season-opening win is its first since the Gaels topped Stony Brook 57-46 on November 11, 2016. It is the first season-opening victory on the road since November 14, 2014 when the Maroon & Gold beat Fordham.
- Winthrop took a 28-15 lead after a 15-0 run in the second quarter, while also holding the Gaels scoreless for a 4:40 second span.
- lona used a 14-0 run in the opening portion of the fourth quarter to regain the lead and extend it to double digits for the first time.
- The Gaels shot 50% or better in the third and fourth quarters, finishing at a 40% clip from the field for the night. Iona held Winthrop to 4-19 shooting in the fourth quarter.
- As a unit, the Maroon & Gold scored 46 of its 68 points in the second half. The Gaels poured in a game-high 24 points in the third period of play.

 THAZINA COOK INDUCTED INTO MAAC HONOR ROLL
- Thazina Cook '10 was elected into the MAAC Honor Roll and was honored at the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, MA this past September.
- Cook is one of five Iona women's basketball players to earn at least two All-MAAC First Team distinctions in her career.
- Cook currently ranks 14th all-time at lona with 1,283 points. She has the sixth-highest three-point shooting percentage in school history at 36.2% and made 297 free throws in her career, the ninth most in program history.
