The Iona Gaels have lost two straight after its season opening win at Winthrop. The Maroon & Gold have yet to put together a full four-quarter effort, but have been a predominantly strong team in the second half, outside of their last contest.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona returns 11 players to its roster for the 2019-20 season, including 7 players who appeared in 20+ games in 2018-19 as well as 94% of its scoring output from last season.
- Sophomore Shyan Mwai has opened the season with three double-digit scoring games, averaging a team-high 17.0 PPG.
- lona welcomes five newcomers: four freshmen and one transfer. The Gaels roster is comprised of 10 underclassmen.
- The Gaels were selected 9th in the 2019-20 MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

SCOUTING THE SEAWOLVES

- Stony Brook suffered its first loss of the season on the road at Arkansas on Sunday.
- The Seawolves have been paced this season by graduate transfer Kaela Hilaire; the former BIG EAST All-Freshman selection is averaging 13.8 PPG and 6.0 APG.
- Stony Brook has played just once at home this season, defeating Manhattan behind a solid performance by Sydney Watkins.
- The Seawolves are led by Caroline McCombs. She is entering her sixth season at the helm and is already the winningest coach in program history.
- SBU was picked second in the America East Preseason Poll.

Billi CHAMBERS

Head Coach Hofstra '03 - Seventh Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her seventh season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

lona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

After an 0-3 start to the year, Iona defeated George Washington at the Hynes Center midway through November. A 20-game slide would follow, spanning non-conference and conference play across a four-month period. The Gaels continued to progress though as a unit under Chambers, and it showed when they topped Monmouth on the road in February.

Iona would enter the MAAC Tournament on a high note, toppling Saint Peter's on the road in the regular season finale and maintaining the 10 seed in the league postseason. In the First Round matchup against the tournament host Siena, the Gaels pulled off the upset over the No. 7 seed, 75-64. Rider would end lona's season the next day, but the foundation for a successful next season had been laid.

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch, being named the MAAC Rookie of the Year unanimously. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four studentathletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led lona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

- Williams, who scored all 11 of her points in the third quarter, set a new career-best in a homecoming for the sophomore transfer.
- Mwai was the only other Gael in double-figures, scoring a teamleading 12 points on 4-12 shooting from the field.
- Morgan Rachu pulled down a team-high seven rebounds; Camilion and Lucia Becerra Perez had two steals each.
- Phoebe Sterba led all scorers on the afternoon, amassing 17 points.
- Kennedy Suttle finished with a double double, scoring 11 points and pulling down a game-high 11 rebounds.
- Kendall Grasela concluded her afternoon with 10 assists, adding three steals as well.

NOTABLE NUGGETS (at PENN)

- lona scored 70+ points in just one game last season, its MAAC Tournament win over Siena.
- The Maroon & Gold outscored the Dukes 49-36 in the second half.
 Duquesne poured in 19 points in the second quarter and limited the Gaels to five points.
- Duquesne's largest lead in this affair was 18 points at the 8:09 mark of the third quarter. The game was tied four times, including once in the final minute.
- The Dukes led for 35:36 of game action; Iona led for just 31 seconds and never led by more than two points.
- The Gaels shot a blistering 60.6% from the floor in the second half and were 7-13 from beyond the arc.
- Despite the size difference all around, the Maroon & Gold held a 42-22 edge in points scored in the paint.
