# IONA HOSTS RIDER IN CONFERENCE HOME OPENER





The Iona College women's basketball team looks to build off of its conference-opening win over the three-time defending champion Quinnipiac Bobcats when they welcome Rider on Saturday. The Broncs got the best of the Gaels three times last season, the last in the MAAC Quarterfinal Round.

### **SCOUTING THE GAELS**

- Iona returns 11 players to its roster for the 2019-20 season, including 7 players who appeared in 20+ games in 2018-19 and 94% of its scoring output from last season.
- Sophomore **De'jah Williams** poured in a career-best 20 points at Quinnipiac. Williams was 9-15 from the floor and knocked down a pair of three-pointers as well.
- The Gaels welcomes five newcomers: four freshmen and one transfer. The Gaels roster is comprised of 10 underclassmen.
- Iona was selected ninth in the 2019-20 MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

### **SCOUTING THE BRONCS**

- Rider is led by the league's Preseason Player of the Year, **Stella Johnson**. The senior enters play leading the nation in scoring average (28.4 PPG).
- Earlier this season, Stella scored a programrecord 41 points vs. Lipscomb as part of the MAAC/ASUN Challenge.
- Senior **Lea Favre** has started the last four games for the Broncs and has scored in double-figures in four straight contests, all of which have been wins.
- Rider is led by head coach Lynn Milligan.
   Under her guidance, Rider has amassed 10+ MAAC wins in three straight seasons.

# Head Coach Hofstra '03 - Seventh Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her seventh season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

lona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

After an 0-3 start to the year, Iona defeated George Washington at the Hynes Center midway through November. A 20-game slide would follow, spanning non-conference and conference play across a four-month period. The Gaels continued to progress though as a unit under Chambers, and it showed when they topped Monmouth on the road in February.

lona would enter the MAAC Tournament on a high note, toppling Saint Peter's on the road in the regular season finale and maintaining the 10 seed in the league postseason. In the First Round matchup against the tournament host Siena, the Gaels pulled off the upset over the No. 7 seed, 75-64. Rider would end lona's season the next day, but the foundation for a successful next season had been laid.

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch, being named the MAAC Rookie of the Year unanimously. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four studentathletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led lona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic

18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

### NOTABLE NUGGETS (W, 75-71 at QUI)

- lona had lost its previous five contests to Quinnipiac. The win was the team's first over the Bobcats since 1/28/17 and the first in Hamden since 2/27/14.
- The win snapped Quinnipiac's 52-game conference winning streak. That mark stood as the 10th longest win streak in the history of Division I women's basketball.
- lona is just the second team to beat Quinnipiac on its home court in the last 51 contests there.
- The Gaels' 75 points marks the team's best scoring output of the season. The team's 36 points at halftime was it's highest of the year as well.
- The Maroon & Gold nearly shot 50% from the field, connecting on 28-57 field goals. Iona hit on 10-13 from the charity stripe as a unit, eight of which came in the final frame.

- She also took part in a piece of program history, when lona won its first-ever national postseason game in a first-round win over LIU Brooklyn in the 2007 WNIT.
- Cook was honored alongside men's basketball player Phil Grant '01.
