IONA HOSTS MONMOUTH RIDING TWO-GAME WINNING STREAK



The Iona College women's basketball team is coming off of a clean sweep of its annual Buffalo swing and looks to take the season series from Monmouth for the first time since 2015-16. The Hawks snapped a six-game losing streak by topping Saint Peter's, 59-57, on Saturday afternoon.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona returns 11 players to its roster for the 2019-20 season, including 7 players who appeared in 20+ games in 2018-19 and 94% of its scoring output from last season.
- The Maroon & Gold surpassed their 2018-19 win total when they defeated Niagara on Saturday. The Gaels have their most wins in a season since 2016-17.
- Sophomore **Juana Camilion** and redshirt freshman **Paula Weekes** were named the MAAC Player and Rookie of the Week. It was Iona's first sweep of the awards since 2013.
- All six of Iona's wins this season have come with a different starting lineup.

SCOUTING THE HAWKS

- Monmouth is averaging a conference low 50.5 PPG offensively, but its 59.2 PPG against is second best in the league.
- Sophomore **Lucy Thomas** was critical in the Hawks' win Saturday, scoring 18 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. She averages 13.5 PPG and 8.1 RPG in league play.
- Senior **Sierra Green** is Monmouth's leading scorer, pouring in 10.3 PPG. Her 50 three-pointers this season are tied for second most in the conference.
- Monmouth is guided by **Jody Craig**. She is in her third season at the helm of the program.

Hofstra '03 - Seventh Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her seventh season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

Iona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

After an 0-3 start to the year, Iona defeated George Washington at the Hynes Center midway through November. A 20-game slide would follow, spanning non-conference and conference play across a four-month period. The Gaels continued to progress though as a unit under Chambers, and it showed when they topped Monmouth on the road in February.

Iona would enter the MAAC Tournament on a high note, toppling Saint Peter's on the road in the regular season finale and maintaining the 10 seed in the league postseason. In the First Round matchup against the tournament host Siena, the Gaels pulled off the upset over the No. 7 seed, 75-64. Rider would end Iona's season the next day, but the foundation for a successful next season had been laid.

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch, being named the MAAC Rookie of the Year unanimously. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic

18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.


