## IONA AIMS FOR SEASON-SERIES SWEEP OF SIENA



The Iona College women's basketball team matches up with Siena for the second time in nine days. The Gaels won the first meeting between the two teams, 58-47 in New Rochelle. The Maroon & Gold could move above .500 in league play for the first time since early January with a win.

### SCOUTING THE GAELS

- The Maroon & Gold have nearly doubled their combined conference win total (5) from the previous two seasons. Iona is one victory shy of doubling its overall win total from 2018-19 (5).
- Iona is looking to move above .500 in league play for the first time since starting conference play 2-1. A win would mark the latest point in a season the Gaels owned an above .500 MAAC record since 2016-17.
- Sophomore **Juana Camilion** lit up Canisius for 28 points, a new career-high, in Iona's 78-72 win on Thursday night. Camilion has reached double-figures 15 times this season.

### SCOUTING THE SAINTS

- Siena is coming off of a loss at Monmouth in which the Saints scored just 18 points in the second half, losing 49-43.
- Siena held Monmouth to 13 first-half points, the lowest opponent total in a half for the Saints' defensive unit.
- Sophomore **Margo Peterson**, who did not play in the first matchup between Iona and Siena, scored a team-high 15 points off of the bench on Thursday night.
- Head coach **Ali Jaques**, in her eighth season, leads Siena. The Saints were voted 10th in the 2019-20 MAAC Preseason Poll.

# Billi CHAMBERS

## Head Coach

### Hofstra '03 - Seventh Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her seventh season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

Iona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

After an 0-3 start to the year, Iona defeated George Washington at the Hynes Center midway through November. A 20-game slide would follow, spanning non-conference and conference play across a four-month period. The Gaels continued to progress though as a unit under Chambers, and it showed when they topped Monmouth on the road in February.

Iona would enter the MAAC Tournament on a high note, toppling Saint Peter's on the road in the regular season finale and maintaining the 10 seed in the league postseason. In the First Round matchup against the tournament host Siena, the Gaels pulled off the upset over the No. 7 seed, 75-64. Rider would end Iona's season the next day, but the foundation for a successful next season had been laid.

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch, being named the MAAC Rookie of the Year unanimously. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic

18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

**NOTABLE NUGGETS (W, 78-72 vs. CAN)**

- Iona's 14 made three-pointers are the program's most since January 8, 2007. The Gaels were one triple shy of tying a program record, set back in January of 2014.
- As a team, the Maroon & Gold connected on 49% of their field goals, 54% of their shots from beyond the arc and 80% of their free throws. The three-point percentage (53.8) is the seventh-highest mark in program history.
- Iona's 16 made free throws are a new season-best and its 18 assists are also a new team-high.
- Three Gaels finished in double-figures: Camilion (28), Rachu (16) and Mwai (11). Tonight marks the 14th consecutive game that at least one of the three has reached double-digit points.
- 69 of Iona's 78 points came in the final three quarters. Iona's 78 points are a new season-best for the team.




