IONA CLASHES WITH MONMOUTH AT THE JERSEY SHORE





Iona and Monmouth enter Saturday afternoon's contest off of losses in which they were held under 40 points. The Gaels and Hawks split the season series last year, with the road team winning both contests. Head coach Billi Chambers is 8-5 all time against Monmouth.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona returns 11 players to its roster for the 2019-20 season, including 7 players who appeared in 20+ games in 2018-19 and 94% of its scoring output from last season.
- Sophomore **Juana Camilion** hit the game-winning shot at Monmouth last year, snapping lona's 20-game skid and securing its first road win over the Hawks since 2016.
- Paulla Weekes had the best game of her career in lona's loss vs. Rider. The freshman recorded new career-bests in points (13) and boards (9), finishing a rebound shy of her first double-double.

SCOUTING THE HAWKS

- Monmouth has lost its last three conference contests since defeating Manhattan in overtime on Dec. 17 to open MAAC play.
- Senior **Sierra Green** was named to the Preseason All-MAAC First Team. Green set the program record for threes in a season last year, knocking down 98.
- Sophomore Lucy Thomas earned a spot on the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team after being named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team a season prior.
- The Hawks are guided by head coach **Jody Craig**. Craig led Monmouth to its best MAAC finish (4th) in her first season in 18-19.

Billi CHAMBERS

Head Coach Hofstra '03 - Seventh Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her seventh season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

lona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

After an 0-3 start to the year, lona defeated George Washington at the Hynes Center midway through November. A 20-game slide would follow, spanning non-conference and conference play across a four-month period. The Gaels continued to progress though as a unit under Chambers, and it showed when they topped Monmouth on the road in February.

lona would enter the MAAC Tournament on a high note, toppling Saint Peter's on the road in the regular season finale and maintaining the 10 seed in the league postseason. In the First Round matchup against the tournament host Siena, the Gaels pulled off the upset over the No. 7 seed, 75-64. Rider would end lona's season the next day, but the foundation for a successful next season had been laid.

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch, being named the MAAC Rookie of the Year unanimously. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four studentathletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led lona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic

18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

 THAZINA COOK INDUCTED INTO MAAC HONOR ROLL
- Thazina Cook '10 was elected into the MAAC Honor Roll and was honored at the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, MA this past September.
- Cook is one of five Iona women's basketball players to earn at least two All-MAAC First Team distinctions in her career.
- Cook currently ranks 14th all-time at Iona with 1,283 points. She has the sixth-highest three-point shooting percentage in school history at 36.2% and made 297 free throws in her career, the ninth most in program history.
- She also took part in a piece of program history, when lona won its first-ever national postseason game in a first-round win over LIU Brooklyn in the 2007 WNIT.
- Cook was honored alongside men's basketball player Phil Grant '01.

MAAC TOURNAMENT RELOCATES TO ATLANTIC CITY, NEW JERSEY

- The Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ will be the new host of the MAAC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships from 2020-22.
- The venue changes over from the Times Union Center, which hosted the postseason tournament every year since 2015.
- The 2020 MAAC Basketball Championship will take place March 10-14 with the women's title game being broadcasted on ESPNNEWS.
