IONA HOSTS NIAGARA IN PLAY 4 KAY GAME





Iona and Niagara meet for the first time in the 2021-22 season on Thursday evening at the Hynes Center. The Gaels and the Purple Eagles split the season series last year. Niagara boasts the number one scoring offense in the MAAC, while Iona ranks as the second-best scoring defense in the league.

IONA VS. NIAGARA - SERIES HISTORY

- Iona and Niagara meet for the 66th time in the overall series history. The Maroon & Gold own a narrow 33-32 edge.
- The Gaels are 10-5 under head coach Billi Chambers against the Purple Eagles. Niagara represents one of five MAAC schools (Canisius, Monmouth, Saint Peter's, Siena) that Chambers has at least 10 victories over.
 Iona is 17-14 all time in New Rochelle and are 11-3 in the last 14 home contests against Niagara. The Purple Eagles have won the previous two, meaning the Gaels will look to beat Niagara at Hynes for the first time since January 13, 2017.

SCOUTING THE PURPLE EAGLES

- Niagara's number one offense in the MAAC (72.4 ppg) has scored at least 70 points in six of its last seven contests and are 5-2 during that span. The Purple Eagles eclipsed 80 points in four of the last seven and are 6-0 this season when scoring at least 80 points.
- Freshman Aaliyah Parker has earned MAAC Rookie of the Week honors six times this season, most recently this past week.
- The Purple Eagles lead the nation in forced turnovers with their opponents averaging over 27 per contest.

BILLI CHAMBERS

Head Coach Hofstra 'O3 - Ninth Season

Iona College women's basketball head coach Billi Chambers enters her eighth season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program in 2020-21.

During the 2019-2020 season the Gaels out-did their predicted finish in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, and finished in a tie for sixth in the standings. The Maroon & Gold began conference play with a win over Quinnipiac, snapping the Bobcats' 52- game conference win streak. The Gaels also swept its annual Western New York swing at Canisius and Niagara for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

Juana Camilion, a 2018-19 MAAC All-Rookie selection, was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. She completed the 2019-20 season ranked No. 18 in the MAAC in scoring, No. 11 in assists per game and No. 4 in steals per game. Camilion earned a spot on the All-MAAC Third Team. Paulla Weekes, was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team, marking the third consecutive season that a member of the Maroon & Gold appeared on the conference's rookie list, and seventh consecutive season that a Gael has appeared on an All-Conference squad

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous selection for MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinal round following an upset of No. 4 Siena in the quarterfinal.

Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016, Chambers led the Iona women's basketball program to its first-ever MAAC tournament championship, taking down top seeded Quinnipiac in the championship game while also earning the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Championship.

Lizarazu and Joy Adams were All-MAAC First Team performers. Lizarazu was Most Outstanding Player in the MAAC Championship. Iona secured the No. 15 seed and fell to regional host, No. 2 University of Maryland.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first-ever MAAC regular season championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

During that 2013-14 campaign, Chambers led the Gaels on a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first-year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named the College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

Prior to her arrival in New Rochelle, Chambers served as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech, on Dennis Wolff's staff when he took over the program in 2011-12. The Hokies improved their Atlantic Coast Conference mark in both seasons under Wolff and Chambers.

At UMBC, Chambers served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Phil Stern for three seasons. During the 2010-11 campaign, the Retrievers finished 20-12, earning the America East regular season championship and a berth into the Women's NIT

Chambers spent two seasons as an assistant at Molloy College in Rockville Centre, New York. Under the tutelage of Tim O'Hagan, she helped guide the Lions to their first-ever East Coast Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2008. Molloy posted a 34-26 overall record in her two seasons on the bench.

While at Molloy, Chambers also served as an athletics administrator. She was the Lions' Associate Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator and Compliance Officer. She joined the Molloy staff after two years in the conference office as Associate Commissioner for Operations and SWA for the ECC.

The Cheverly, Maryland native attended Archbishop Carroll High School, where she was inducted into the Hall of Fame in the spring of 2018. She was a four-year letter winner at Hofstra, appearing in 79 games and making 28 starts from 1999-2003. She earned a bachelor's degree in psychology in May 2003 and a master's degree in psychology from Adelphi University in November 2005.

Chambers and her wife, Melba, reside in Norwalk, Connecticut.

IONA SIXTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was selected by the league's coaches to finish sixth, just ahead of Niagara.
- The Quinnipiac Bobcats were selected as the preseason favorites to win the MAAC, receiving six of 11 first place votes. Fairfield's Lou Lopez-Senechal was voted the MAAC Preseason Player of the Year.
- The defending MAAC Champion Marist Red Foxes were predicted to finish third, garnering just one first place vote. Manhattan and Fairfield split the remaining four votes.

GAELS BRING IN FIVE NEWCOMERS TO NEW ROCHELLE FOR 2021-22 SEASON

- Iona welcomes five fresh faces to the program for the 2021-22 season. Three of Iona's five newcomers are freshmen: Marina Cenis, Judith Gomez and Addy Salzer.
- The Gaels brought in a pair of transfers for the upcoming season: Jazmin Benn (Biola University), and Isabelle Lipinski (Franklin Pierce).
- The five newcomers join a returning class of 11 Gaels, 10 of whom will be upperclassmen in the 2021-22 season.

MAAC CONTINUES UNITED FOR JUSTICE CAMPAIGN

- As a collection of colleges and universities committed to racial justice and individual dignity, the MAAC has committed to work with others in college sports to foster understanding and effect lasting change to advance social justice.
- Elements of the multi-year campaign can be found on school campuses, live game broadcasts, online, on social media and on the court.
- MAAC basketball programs will be focusing their efforts specifically on Black Lives Matter by wearing BLM uniform patches and coaches' pins throughout the season. They will also be able to showcase individualized social justice messaging on their warmup shirts. Additionally, the conference has supplied floor decals for member institutions to use on their home courts in an effort to spread awareness.

CAMILION NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

- Senior Juana Camilion was named to the 2021-22 Preseason All-MAAC Second Team.
- Camilion was an All-MAAC Third Teamer last season, the second straight season she appeared on the league's third team.
- Last season, Camilion averaged 12.7 points, 4.9 rebounds and 2.9 assists across 33.8 minutes per game.
- She finished the season with 52 steals and 3.5 steals per game, which led the MAAC. That mark ranked fourth in the NCAA.

GAELS RETURN PLETHORA OF SCORERS FOR 2021-22 CAMPAIGN

- Iona welcomes back six of its seven top scorers from the year prior.
- The Maroon & Gold return the top three scorers from the 2020-21 season in Juana Camilion, Olivia Vezaldenos and Ketsia Athias.
- Camilion finished with the seventh highest scoring average in the conference, Vezaldenos was the leading scorer among all MAAC players who started less than a third of their teams games and Athias reached double-digit points in three of her six contests last year.

MAAC TOURNAMENT CONTINUES ON IN ATLANTIC CITY, NEW JERSEY FOR 2021-22

- The Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ is the new host of the MAAC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships from 2020-22.
- The venue changed over from the Times Union Center, which hosted the postseason tournament every year since 2015.
- The 2022 MAAC Basketball Championship will take place March 8-12 with all games being broadcasted on the ESPN family of networks.
