Iona College Goal Club Hall of Fame

Maggie Muldoon '77 Inducted, June 1986

The first woman to be inducted into the Goal Club Hall of Fame was also a part of several other "firsts" at Iona. As an athlete, Muldoon became the first player in women's basketball history to go over the 1,000 point mark for her career. The 4'8" point guard led the Gaels to the first 20-win season at the varsity level, a 24-8 mark in 1976-77. For her career, Muldoon averaged 13 points per game, with a career-high 33 points coming in her sophomore year against St. Peter's college. The mark still stands as the highest single-game point total in Iona history.



After her playing career ended, Muldoon remained at Iona as an assistant coach under Sandie Capifali, as well as becoming the college's softball coach. It was as the softball coach that Muldoon took part in still another "first" in women's athletics at Iona, helping the softball team make the transition from club status to varsity competition.

It is both as an athlete and as a coach that Maggie Muldoon set the standard for women's athletics at Iona.

Maggie Timoney '89 Inducted, June 2001

Maggie Timoney enters the Iona College Goal Club Hall of Fame as one of the greatest women's basketball players in the history of the program. A four-year standout for the Gaels, Timoney currently ranks as Iona's all-time leading point scorer, tallying 1,894 career points.

As a freshman, Timoney was named the Metro Atlantic Athletic conference Rookie of the Year and her 12.7 points per game still ranks as the top freshman scoring average in Iona history. She led the team in scoring in each of her next three years, averaging a program-best 16.6 points per game throughout her career. As a sophomore, Timoney was named to the All-MAAC First team after averaging 19.9 points per game. Timoney ranks among the top-five all-time in the Iona record book in seven other offensive categories, including ranking first in field goal attempts, three point field goal percentage and free throws made and attempted lists.

After graduation, Timoney served for two years as a graduate assistant coach for the Gaels from 1989-91.



Celeste Grier-Johnathan '82 Inducted, June 1996

Celeste Grier-Johnathan enters the Iona College Goal Club hall of Fame as one of Iona College's best-ever women's basketball players.

During her four year career, she was an integral part of some of Iona's most successful teams ever. Between 1978-1982, she helped lead Iona to a 59-52 record and two consecutive EAIW Northeast Regional Finals. She averaged 13.0 points and 6.6 rebounds, while shooting 43.4% from the floor during her 111-game career.

Grier-Johnathan is currently the fifth all-time leading scorer in Iona women's basketball history with 1,441 points and the fourth leading rebounder, corraling 737 rebounds. She also ranks in the top-10 in eight other career statistical categories, including assists (eighth with 249).

Patty Reynolds- Basile '90 Inducted, June 2004



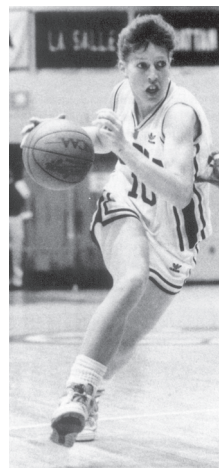
Patty Reynolds-Basile '90 entered the Goal Club Hall of Fame in June 2004.

Reynolds-Basile is the second all-time leading scorer in Gael history, tallying 1,683 points in her 110 game career. She is Iona's all-time leader in field goals made and attempted, while ranking second in career steals (229), scoring average (15.3) and third in assists (393).

During her career, Reynolds-Basile scored 25 or more points seven times, tallying a career-high of 29 points twice during her senior year. As a freshman, Reynolds-Basile averaged 15.3 points per contest en route to being named the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Rookie of the Year in 1987. It was the second-highest scoring average by an Iona freshman in program history.

As a junior, Reynolds-Basile was a Second Team All-MAAC selection. She averaged 14.6 points and 4.0 rebounds while shooting 52.0% from the floor. As a senior, she led the team with a 16.5 points per game average - the sixth-highest single-season scoring averages - while dishing out a team-best 106 assists.

In addition to her outstanding play on the court, Reynolds-Basile was also honored for her efforts in the classroom, earning a spot on the MAAC's All-Academic team during her junior and senior seasons.



Postseason Tournament Play

The Iona College women's basketball team earned a postseason berth for the first time in school history in 2007, and repeated the feat for a second consecutive year in 2008. The Gaels advanced to the second round of the Women's National Invitation Tournament after finishing second overall in the regular season and in the conference tournament both years.

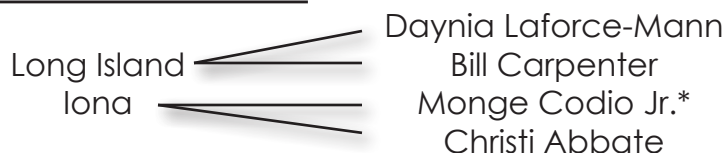

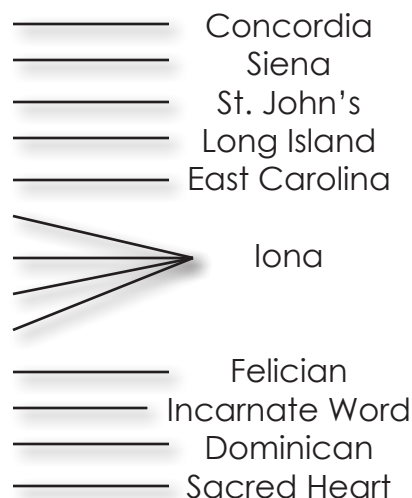
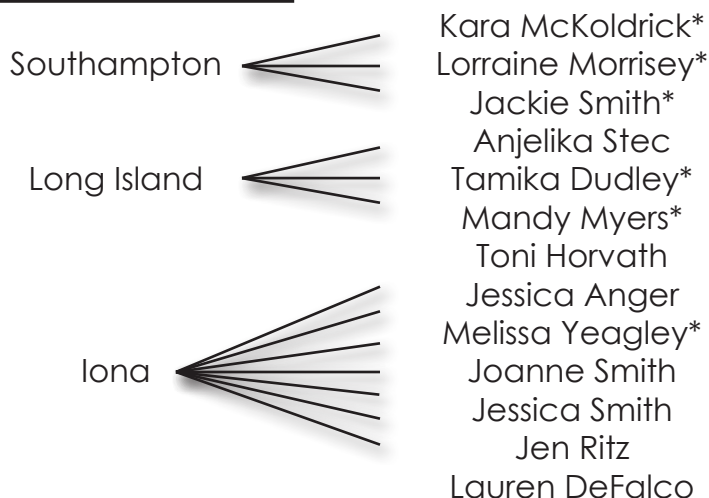
